FERPA RELEASE

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) is a Federal law that protects the privacy of student education records. The law applies to all schools that receive funds under an applicable program of the U.S. Department of Education. While FERPA gives parents certain rights with respect to their children's education records, these rights transfer to the student when he or she reaches the age of 18 or attends a school beyond the high school level (Source: 20 U.S.C. § 1232g; 34 CFR Part 99).

By signing this FERPA Release, the student gives consent to the Las Positas Disabled Student Programs and Services (DSPS) staff to discuss his or her educational program, progress, and academic accommodations while attending college with a parent, guardian, spouse, or supportive third party individual as requested by the student. By default, no student records will be released to anyone unless this form is completed and on file. This agreement can be terminated in writing or in person at the DSPS office. I also acknowledge that this release is void one year after my last semester at Las Positas College.
