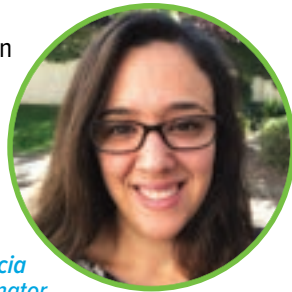
Community Education at Las Positas College is excited to announce the Spring 2024 catalog!

High Desert: Black, Punk, Nowhere

Get ready for our annual Literary Arts Festival keynote speaker and join Michelle Cruz Gonzales, author of *The Spitboy Rule: Tales of a Xicana in a Female Punk Band* (2016) to discuss *High Desert: Black, Punk, Nowhere* (2022), the acclaimed graphic memoir by James Spooner, director of the award-winning documentary film *Afropunk*. In *High Desert*, James is mixed race, acutely aware of his Blackness, and he doesn't know where he fits until he meets Ty, a young Black punk who introduces him to the school outsiders - skaters, unhappy young rebels also coming of age in Apple Valley, a thirsty, desert town somewhere in California. We will start the discussion with light refreshments and an ice breaker activity. Copies of his book will soon be available at the library and campus bookstore.

Las Positas College Institute of Piano Technology Part 2

This is Part 2 of a certificate course & training program for motivated students in the field of piano technology. Piano tuning, repair & regulation will be taught in an immersive, hands-on program using practice pianos & the LPC Fleet. At the end of the course, you should be able to tune a piano competently, initiate common field repairs & prepare to study for the Piano Technician Guild Examinations. Students are required to practice, purchase reading materials & tools. This class utilizes tuning software to learn to tune solid unisons & gain competency expeditiously, so it is recommended to obtain a free/affordable piano tuning software/app. Both parts, Part 1 and 2, must be completed, classes attended regularly & milestones met to receive the Certificate of Occupational Preparation. Access to a piano to practice on is recommended, but other arrangements may be made with the instructor. Minimum of 5 documented piano tunings must be performed. Students arrange their own externships after they have received adequate training.

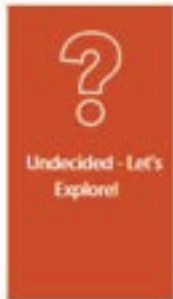
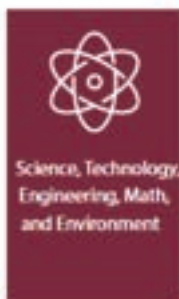
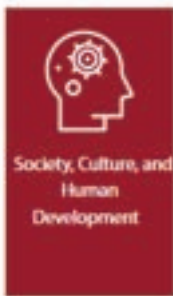
