Pool Setup Expectations

Fall 2023

*Please note that upon departure the pool must be left in the conditions listed below

1) For the nights when LPC water polo is the first in the pool for the day (Tu/Th/Fri). Or for whoever is last and is covering the pool, a few lane lines need to be in to keep the tarps from drifting when polo is in the water first the following day.

 $\cdot 1$ lane line left in at the first position next to the wall, windscreen side

 \cdot 1 lane line left in at the middle 7ft depth marker (between lanes 5 & 6).

·1 lane line left at the 13ft marker, between lanes 10-11

·All other lane lines pulled out on the deck, past the small drain line on the pool deck (pictured)

·Water polo cages.

o*1 left against the windscreen, center of the pool between the pace clocks (pictured),



o *1 against the windscreen and light pole behind lane 9 & Make sure NOT to block the path to the storage room, showers, or handicap lift. (pictured)





•Flags should put back up each night. The users are welcome to take them down for their usage, but it is best for to put them back up each night.

 \cdot All (LPC & user) equipment is stored in its appropriate place

2) For the nights when swimming is the first group in (Mon/Wed nights).

• Last user needs to make sure lane lines are in AND tightened up to the 13 ft. marker (between lanes 10-11), flags are up AND lined up correctly.

 \cdot All (LPC & user) equipment is stored in its appropriate place

3) For Tu/Th mornings when it is Swimming, then polo after.

 $\cdot 1$ lane line left in at the first position next to the wall, windscreen side

 $\cdot 1$ lane line left at the 13ft marker, between lanes 10-11

·All other lane lines pulled out on the deck, past the small drain line on the pool deck (pictured)



·Flags can be left in place.

 \cdot All (LPC & user) equipment is stored in its appropriate place
