

If you missed the March 2nd Cal Grant deadline for FAFSA/DREAM, you should still file your FAFSA or DREAM application.

Use the correct form:

FAFSA: (<https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa>)

For U.S. citizens and documented eligible noncitizens in legal immigration status

CALIFORNIA DREAM APPLICATION:

(<https://dream.csac.ca.gov/>)

For undocumented students who are **AB540-eligible** through Admissions (graduated from California high school and attended a California high school for 3 years)

DID YOU KNOW...

If you haven't yet filed a 2018-2019 FAFSA or DREAM Application for the current school year, it's not too late!!

You can still qualify to receive a Retroactive fee waiver for last summer, fall, or current spring terms and a (FAFSA) Pell grant if you qualify! Previous enrollment fees paid may be refunded after you apply for refund!

Your application must be submitted by May 24, 2019 to qualify for a retroactive fee waiver. The deadline for a fee waiver is the last day of spring semester.
