## **AMERICAN INDIANS COMMITTEE AMERICAN INDIAN SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION**

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** The American Indians Committee of the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution awards scholarships to Native Americans. This award is intended to help Native American college and technical school students of any age, any tribe, in any state striving to obtain an education. All awards are judged based on financial need and academic achievement.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Applicants must be enrolled members of a Native American tribe recognized at the federal or state level. In addition, applicants must be in financial need and have a **grade point average of at least 3.25 based on a 4.0 scale or its equivalent. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

**AREA OF STUDY:** OPEN. Programs may be vocational training or college/university at the undergraduate or graduate level. Graduate students are eligible; however, undergraduate students are given preference.

**AMOUNT OF AWARD:** The scholarship is a one-time award of \$4,000. The money is sent directly to the respective school.

**DEADLINES:** **No later than February 15 midnight EST in a single email**

**APPLICATION PROCEDURES:** The following must be included in **one email. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

1. Letter giving minimal family history, basic financial status, and education objective.
  - a. Lengthy genealogies or detailed financial reports **are not required.**
2. Official copy of last semester transcript, or last transcript obtained. They cannot be emailed separately.
3. Three letters of recommendation from persons such as teachers, clergy, or others who have personally known applicant for a minimum of two years. These letters must be included in packet and cannot be emailed separately.
4. Proof of American Indian blood as indicated by one of the following:
  - a. A card issued by a Tribal Council
  - b. A letter from the Tribal Council

**NOTE:** *No ACT or SAT scores are required.*

Only **fully** executed applications, **submitted in one email package**, will be considered. Incomplete applications will be discarded. Application must be typed or computer generated. The National Vice Chair will notify applicants of receipt of their applications by email. Only those students who receive scholarships will be notified by email.

All information must be included on the application or it will not be considered. Applications must be emailed to the National Vice Chair at the address listed above.
