'Satisfactory Academic Progress Workshops for Financial Aid

January 17, 2017 through February 14, 2017

Who should attend?

Disqualified students who want to learn how to regain their financial aid eligibility at LPC. Students on WARNING are welcome to attend to ensure they are aware of how to maintain eligibility in the future.

If you are currently on financial aid disqualification due to poor progress (*with the exception of Excessive Units Disqualification*), you are encouraged to attend a workshop to better understand the financial aid standards of progress, and to learn how to regain your financial aid. You will find out if you are a possible candidate for an appeal of a disqualification, and if so you will learn the procedure, expectations, and timeline.

This workshop is MANDATORY if you intend to file a Petition for Reinstatement of Financial Aid if you are currently disqualified.

PLEASE NOTE: Attendance does not guarantee approval of a petition. It is a step required in the process of filing a petition. Students filing a petition must also obtain a complete **Student Education Plan (SEP)** from Counseling. Information will be provided at the workshop.

NO REGISTRATION REQUIRED.

Just come to a workshop.

You must be on time! Absolutely no admission after the workshop begins.

Please do not bring children.

The workshops are approximately one hour, but allow more time if you want to meet with a financial aid representative following the workshop to discuss your personal SAP status and situation.
