



- Awarded Degrees between 2016-17 through 2021-22
- First-time degree recipients who were awarded one degree
- Earned at least 60 degree-applicable units
- Enrolled in the year the degree was awarded

Ensure that learning is happening with intentional outcomes.



### 2016-17 through 2021-22






Graphically demonstrates the spread of data through quartiles






### Years to Graduation by Degree Type




### Years to Graduation by Degree Type




Earned Degree Units by Degree Type




Years to Graduation by Unit Load in First Primary Semester




Age at Initial Enrollment by Degree Type




### Age at Graduation by Degree Type
