




CCCCO: Transfer Velocity – Transfer Rate

 - Tracks student transfer rate (%) over a six-year period. Narrow by demographic and/or special category, and/or student start year.
 - View rates by Statewide, District or College.


CCCCO: Transfer Volume – ISP and OOS

- CCC Transfer Volume (#) to In-State Private (ISP) and Out-of-State (OOS) Four-Year Institutions
 - Tracks student transfer volume to In-State Private (ISP) and Out-of-State (OOS) institutions by year.
 - View sending volumes by Statewide, District, or College.
 - View destination volumes by overall (ISP or OOS) or individual institutions.



 - Total applicants, admits, and enrollments by source school, ethnicity, gender, average GPA
 - Select the "Transfer" related tabs or drop-down reports

• <u>UC Transfers by Major</u> – Step-by-step instructions




- Transfer Admission Rate by UC Campus / UC Major
 - Select the "By Major Name" tab to view Apply/admit/enroll, GPA ranges (middle 50%), admit rate and yield rate by major to the UC system or specific UC campus.
 - Search for a major then select result under "Broad Discipline" to compare broad discipline admission data for each UC campus.
- Transfer Enrollments by Community College / UC Major
 - Select the "By Community College" tab to view college-level enrollments by major to a specific UC campus.




- Includes annual (2000->) transfer application, admission and enrollment data
- Filter by CSU system / campus and Community College campus
- Disaggregate data by ethnicity, gender, age, residency
- Includes Discipline/Program Area, ADT status, Transfer GPA, units attempted and GPA one year after transfer

- Reports and Analytics: Step-by-Step Instructions
 - Select College Year and California Community College Transfers to CSU, select "Go"



- Download and open the Report (Excel file) be sure to "Enable Editing"
- Display transfer data by Year, CSU campus, Ethnicity, Sex, CSU Concentration
- Additional tabs available: CCC by CSU Concentration, and CSU Concentration and Ethnicity
- For Both Excel Reports Right-Click between Tabs and select "Unhide" to access Raw Data!
 - Highlight header row, then use "Filter" command to display LPC data
