San Francisco Bay Area

Las Positas College is in an ideal location to access many world renown attractions. Our proximity to the major Bay Area cities such as San Francisco, San Jose, Oakland, and Berkeley provides many unique cultural opportunities.

Visit several museums, libraries, art galleries, aquariums, planetariums, theaters, sports events, and concerts in the immediate surrounding area. Las Positas' nearness to the Pacific Ocean and Sierra Nevada mountains offers excellent recreational activities. The Pacific Coast is 1.5 hours to the west, Lake Tahoe and Yosemite National Park are 4 to 5 hours to the east, Silicon Valley is 1 hour to the south, and the Napa Valley is 2 hours to the north.



ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS



Las Positas College **requires** an English Language Proficiency exam such as **TOEFL** or **IELTS** is for admission.

Students who submit iBT TOEFL scores 45-60 or Academic IELTS scores of 5.0 may be required to take intermediate or advanced College English as a Second Language (ESL) courses to increase their English proficiency. These ESL courses are designed to advance your academic English language skills of reading, writing and grammar while preparing you for academic success.


