XIV. OFFICER REPORTS

EXECUTIVE OFFICERS

Brody Price – President (Chair)

Brody informed the Student Senate that the health center is open to drop-in appointments, or they allow for students to schedule one. Open from 9-5 on Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday, and Tuesdays 9-7pm, and Fridays 9-1 PM. Yesterday he attended the Board of Trustees meeting and gave a report of upcoming LPCSG events and recognitions of senators/clubs. The market will be next week; help is needed. He reminds student government members to fill out the committee template during our committee meetings. Brody met with President Foster, VP Wilson, and Director Taylor on 10/11. They discussed working on adding more food options and later closing time for the cafeteria. Next Fall the cafeteria might be open later for evening classes. They discussed a Student Center and a larger area for students to work together, socialize, and to have senate meetings and club meetings. He also informed them of the possibility of a cultural events resolution coming forth.

President Foster spoke regarding the incident posted on social media between two individuals on the LPC campus. He is looking to engage in dialogue with the individuals and learn more about what happened. He informed the Senate and public that he is engaging with the district attorney's office and will be following administrative procedure and board policy.



A student from the public asked about the enrollment status of the student. President Foster informed everyone that due to FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act) he is unable to reveal information on the student's enrollment status.

Shreshth asked about plans to prevent this issue in the future. President Foster said that to prevent situations like this the school will talk with students about freedom of expression more in the future and educate them.

Mahi asked if there are any concerns about being contacted about outside media outlets (not in the college). President Foster informed us that Chip Woerner will be handling all information on this situation regarding the media outlets.

Nada asked if there will be future statements about the situation from the college. President Foster said that the campus has a diverse population. He acknowledges that the statements out are not hitting the right note with everyone. He said that he had received hundreds of emails.

Omar asked about resources available to students and employees for mental health. President Foster informed that students take advantage of resources. If there are any concerns with resources reach out to President Foster. He has asked campus security to be more visible on campus. Has reached out to Livermore PD on Monday.

Mahi asked about digital safety for students. President Foster informed that they are taking precautions in the IT department and that threats have been made and the college is making sure they provide ample support and safety.

Britney asked about the best approach for being in a situation like this. President Foster said that we have the student code of conduct where you can say what happened to you and report it. You can report to campus safety. Campus safety has the penal code and other laws that they are mindful of. He encourages students to not engage in those situations. Also, if you witness it report it

Delaney asked about resources available to keep students safe. President Foster referred to campus safety for the matter.
