California State University (CSU) Associate Degree For Transfer (ADT)

Associate Degrees for Transfer (ADT), also known as Associate in Arts for Transfer (AA-T) and Associate in Science for Transfer (AS-T) degrees are intended primarily for students who plan to transfer into a similar baccalaureate major at a California State University (CSU) campus. Students who earn an ADT and meet certain CSU admission requirements are guaranteed priority admission to a CSU campus though not necessarily to a specific campus or major.

FACTS: California State University Associate Degree for Transfer Pathway

- The ADT is an option that allows students to complete an associate degree while satisfying general education and major requirements for transfer.
- The ADT follows a prescribed pattern of courses for specific majors.
- Students are guaranteed admission to a California State University (CSU) campus.
- For impacted CSU campuses and majors, students with guaranteed transfer degrees are given additional consideration for transfer admission.

University Of California (UC) Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)

FACTS: University of California Transfer Admission Guarantee Pathway

- Transfer agreements guarantee transfer admission without an obligation to attend.
- Specific courses and grades are required depending on the major or program impaction criteria.
- Students may apply for a UC TAG to only one participating UC campus, but may apply for transfer to any UC campus.
- Students should meet with an academic counselor during their first year of enrollment to complete a Student Education Plan to plan for and ensure eligibility for UC TAG.

Transfer pathways to UC Berkeley, UCLA, and UC San Diego are available but not guaranteed.

The University of California (UC) Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) is a formal, written agreement that provides guaranteed admission to California community college students who meet and fulfill specific requirements.
