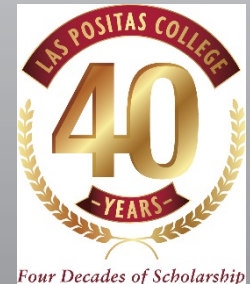

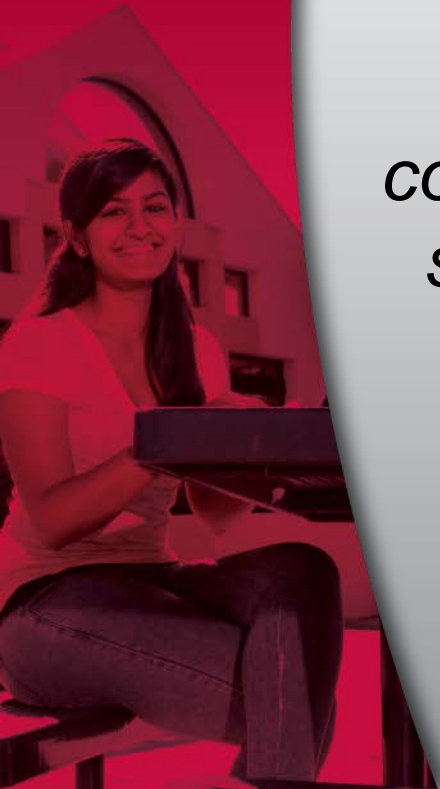

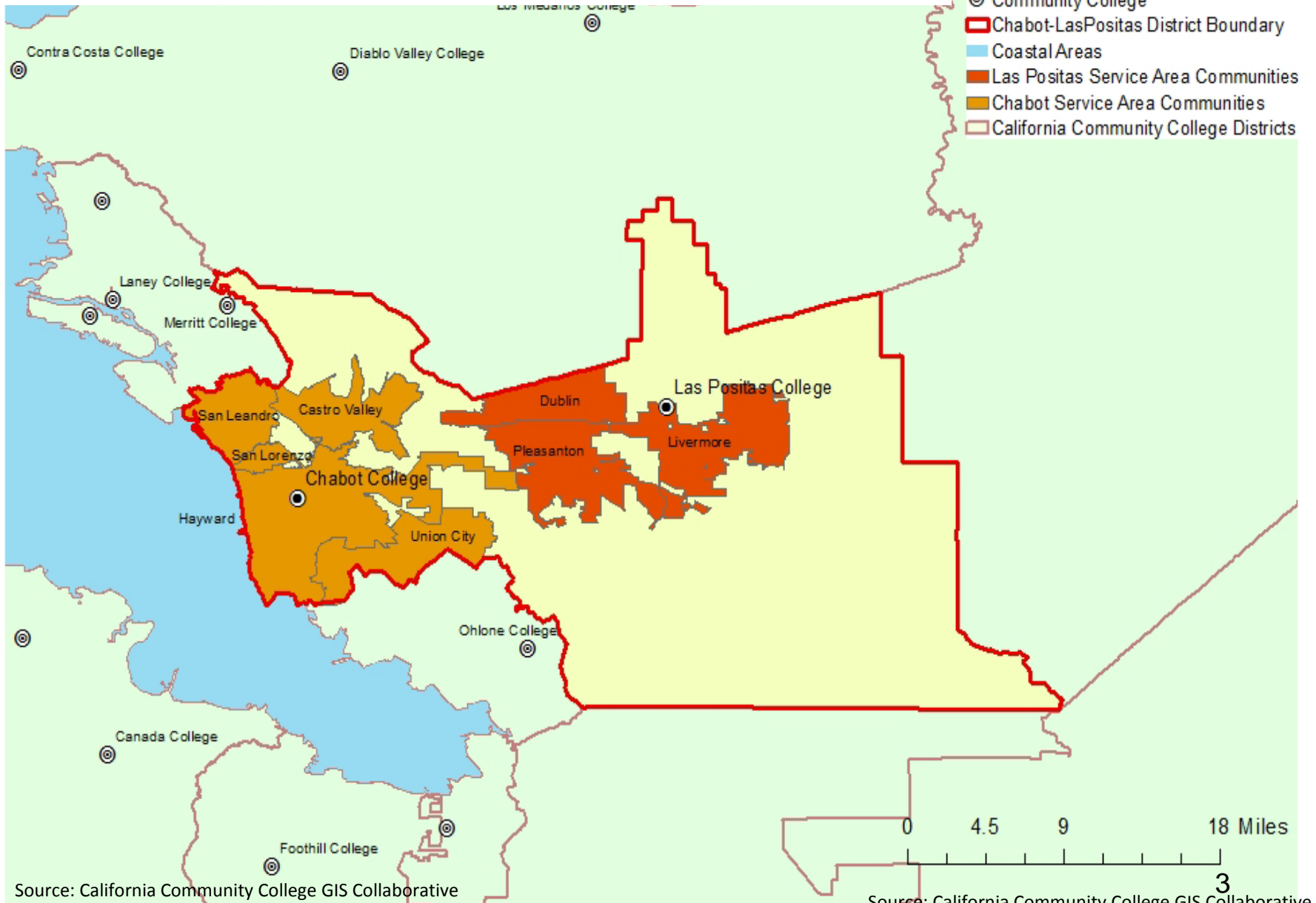


Las Positas College – Our Community's College

Las Positas College is an inclusive learning-centered institution providing educational opportunities and support for completion of students' transfer, degree, basic skills, career-technical, and retraining goals



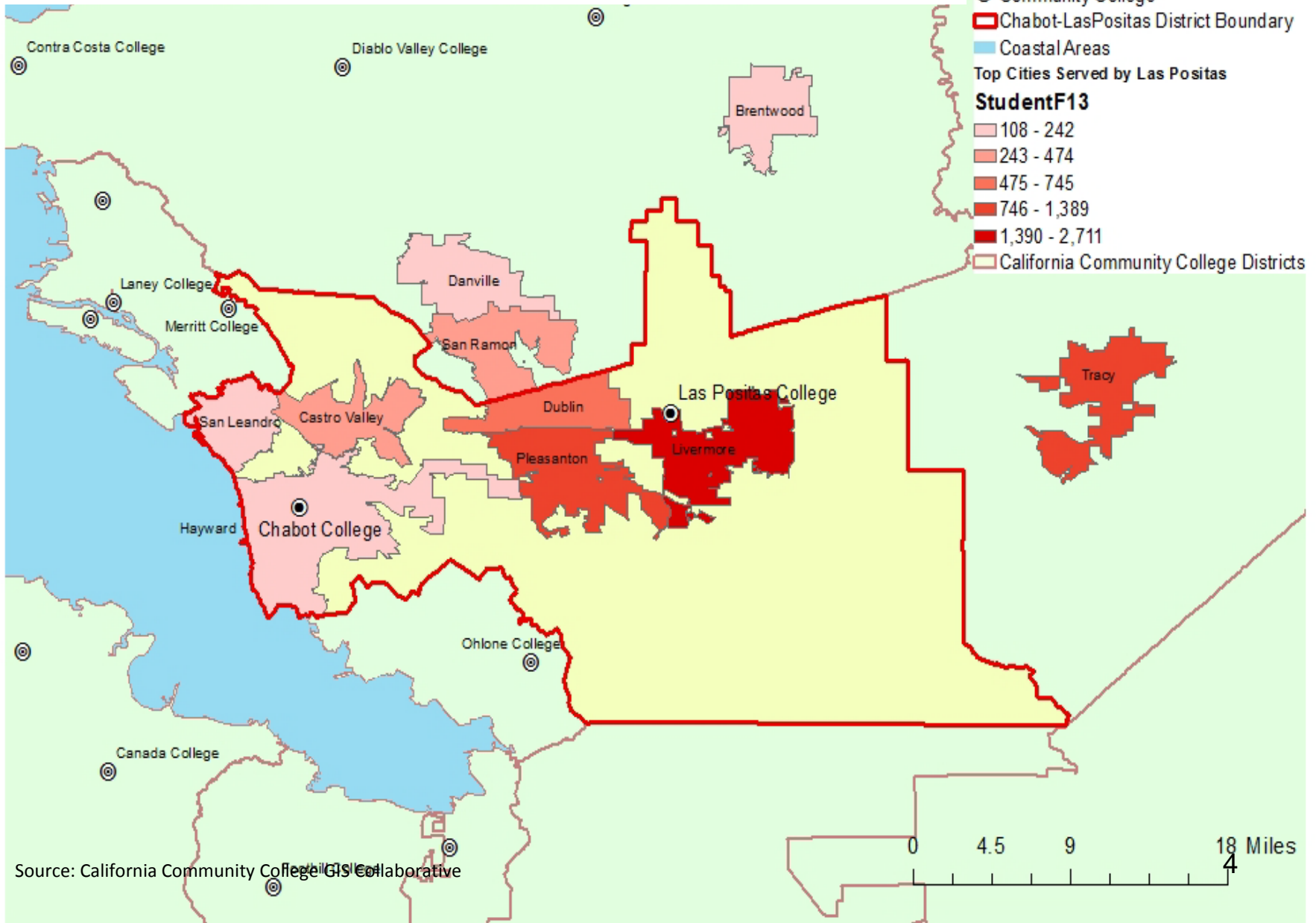
CLPCC District Service Area

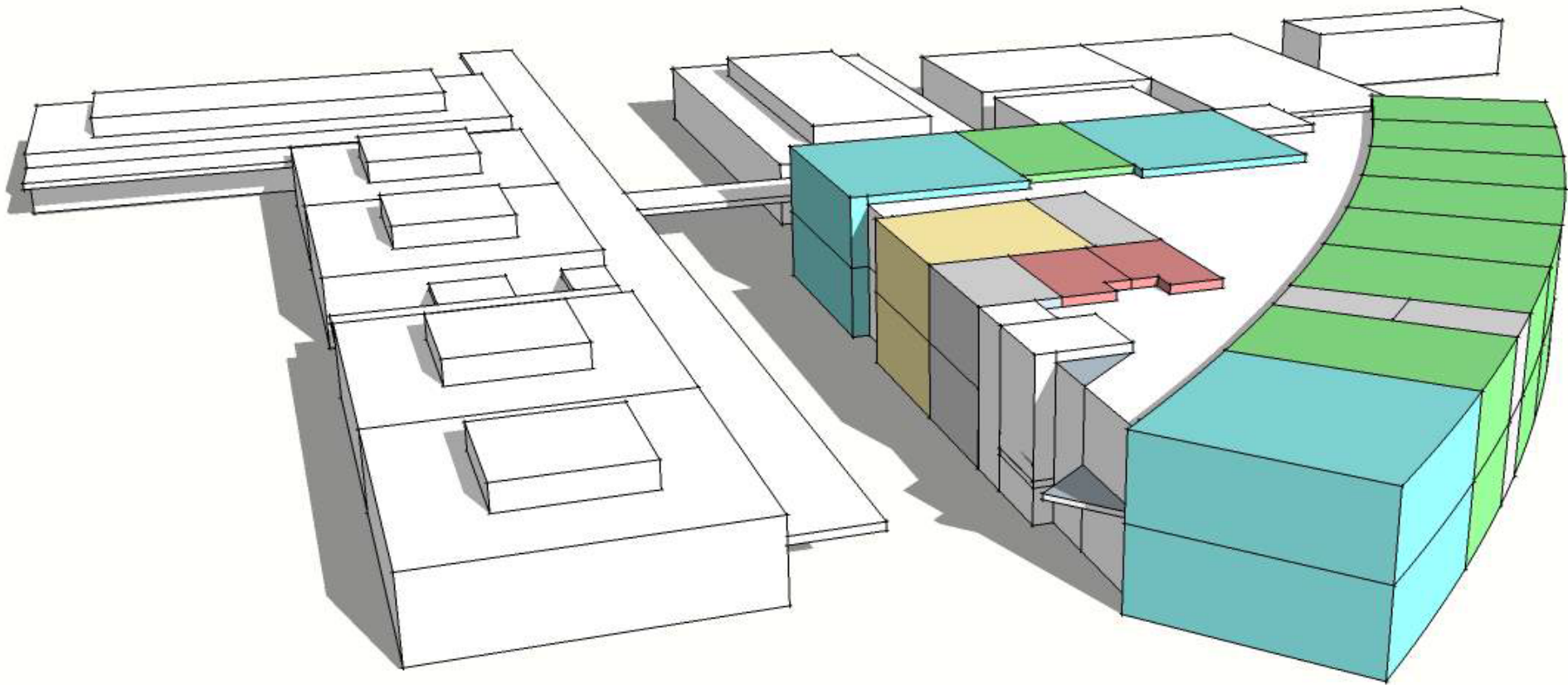

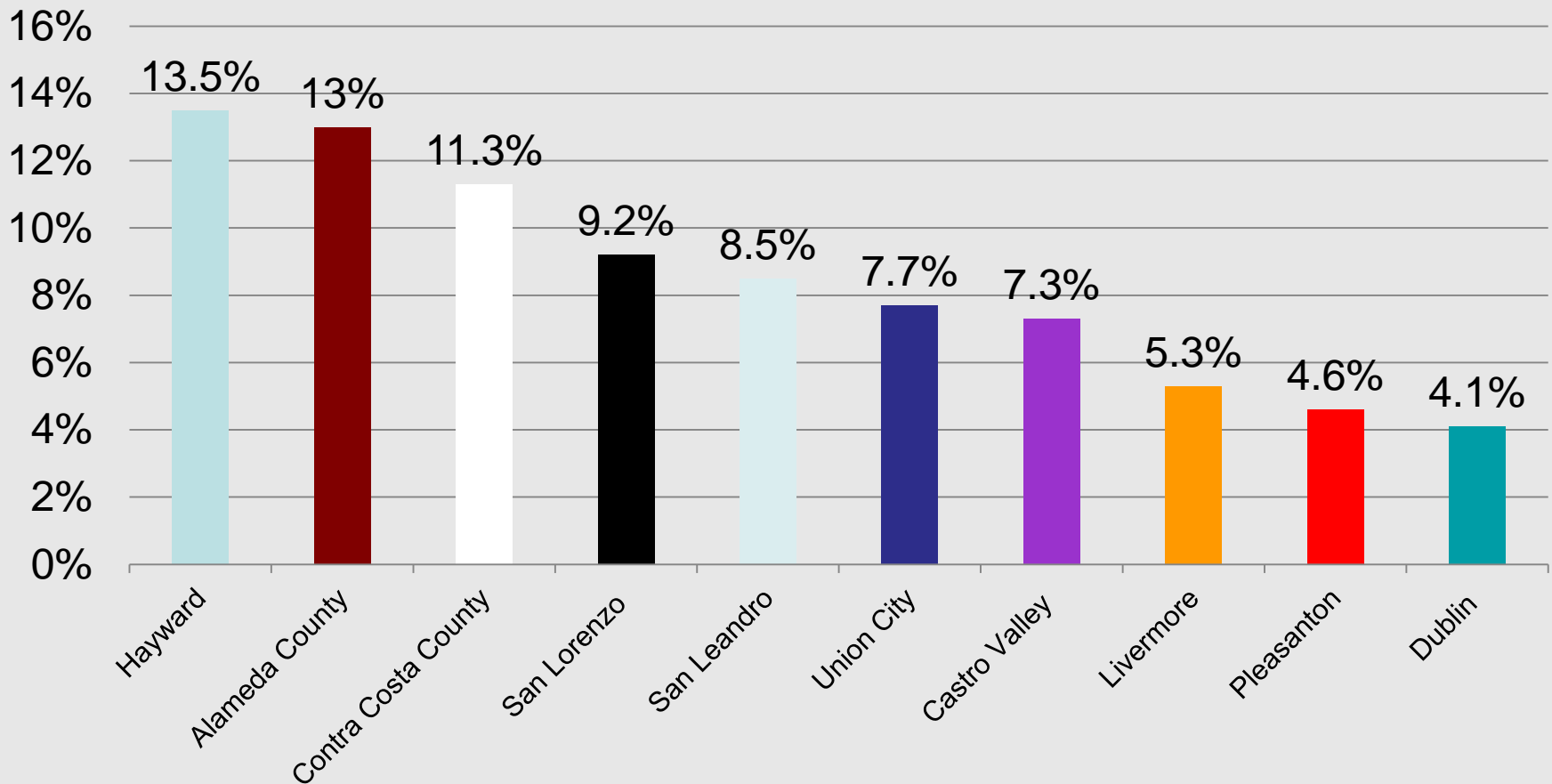

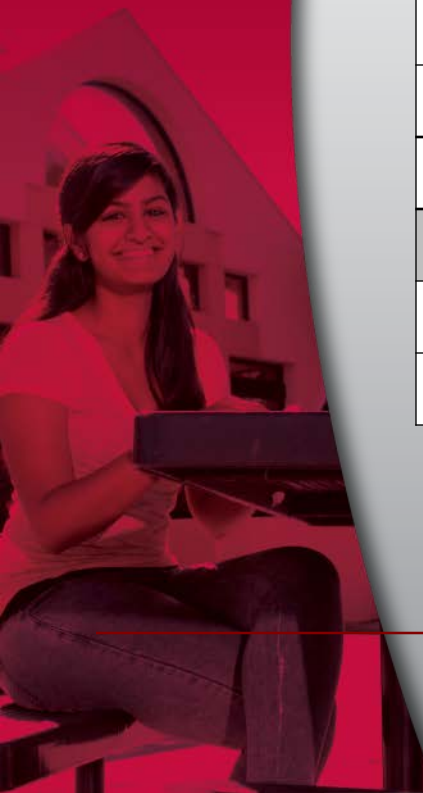

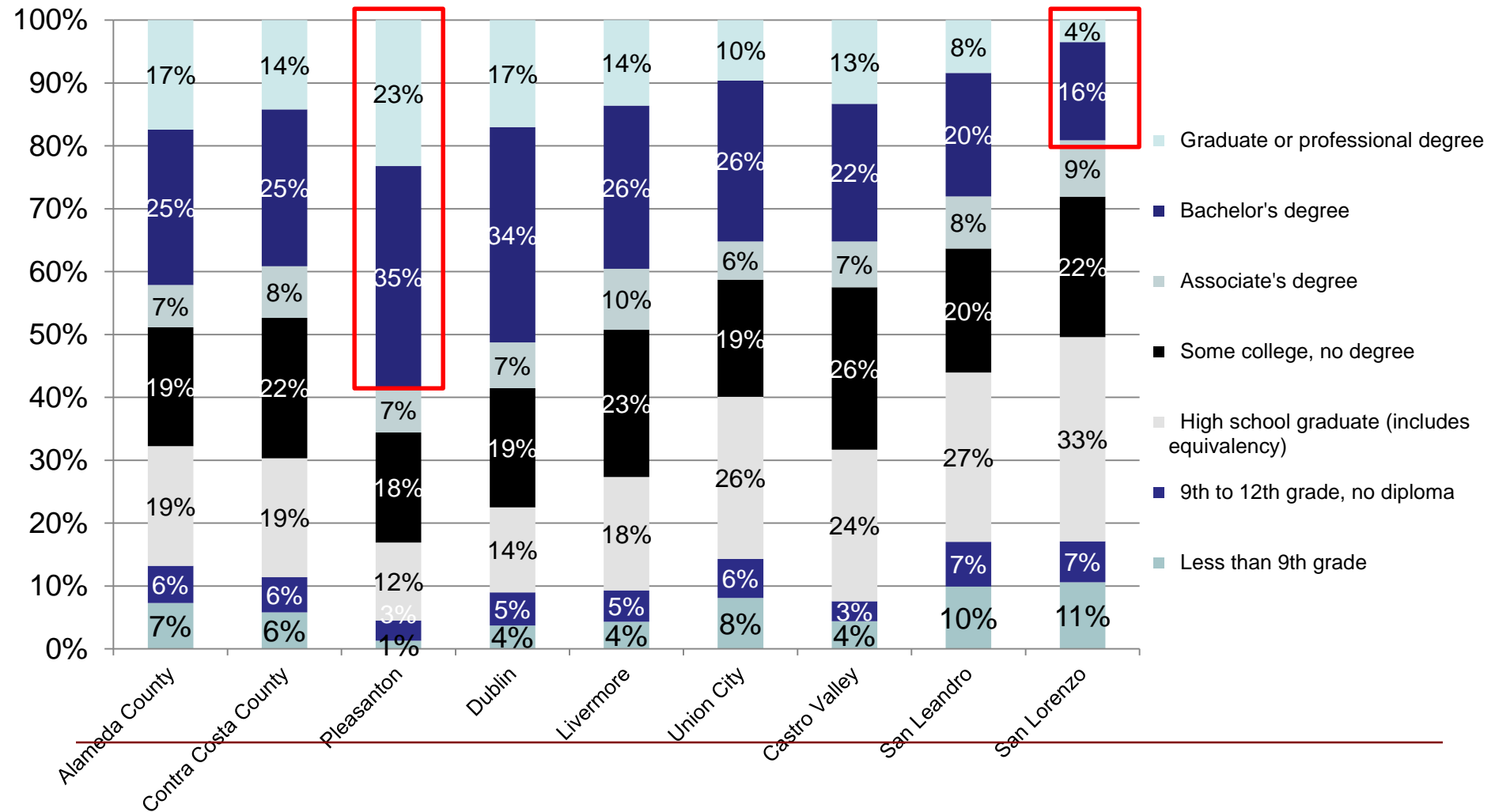

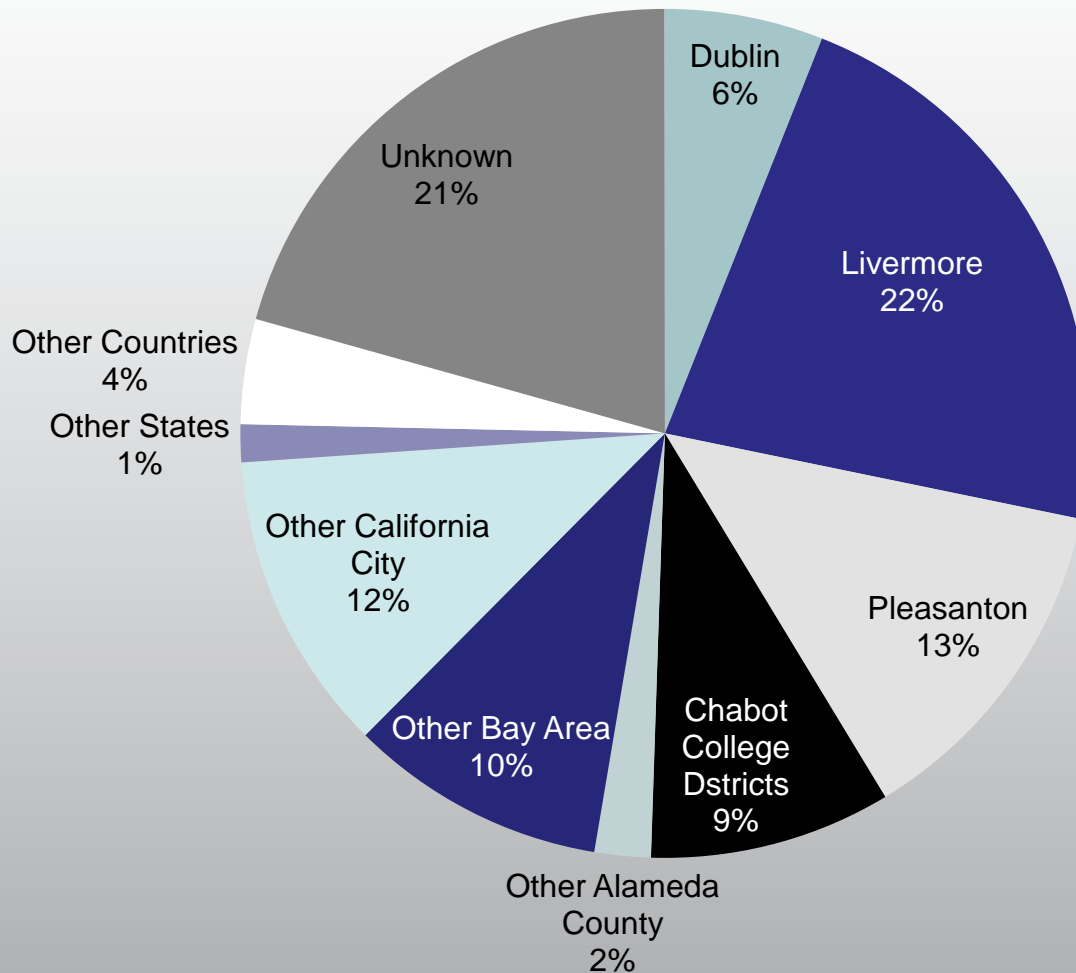

Educational Attainment

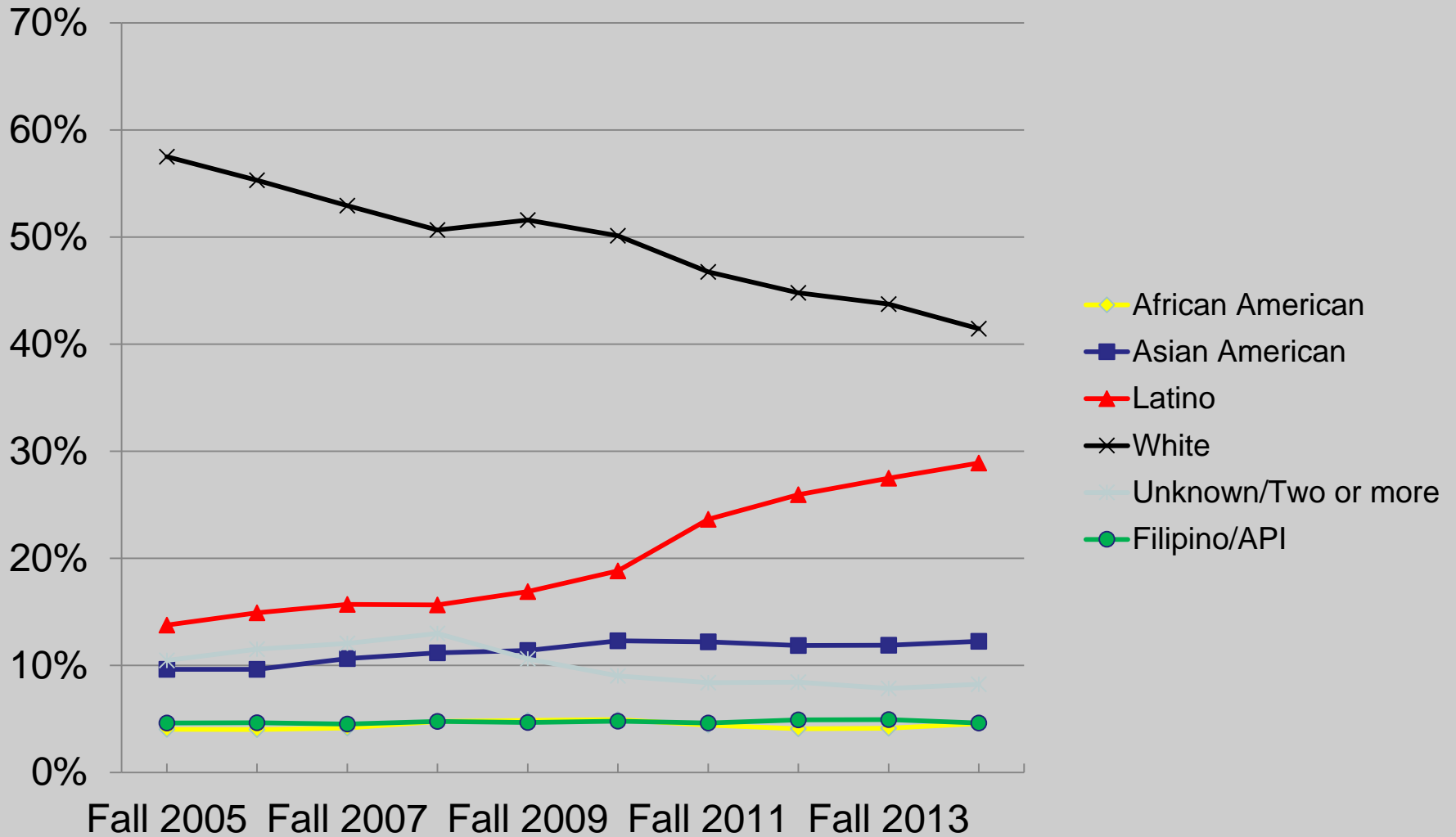


School Districts of Incoming High School Students Fall 2013

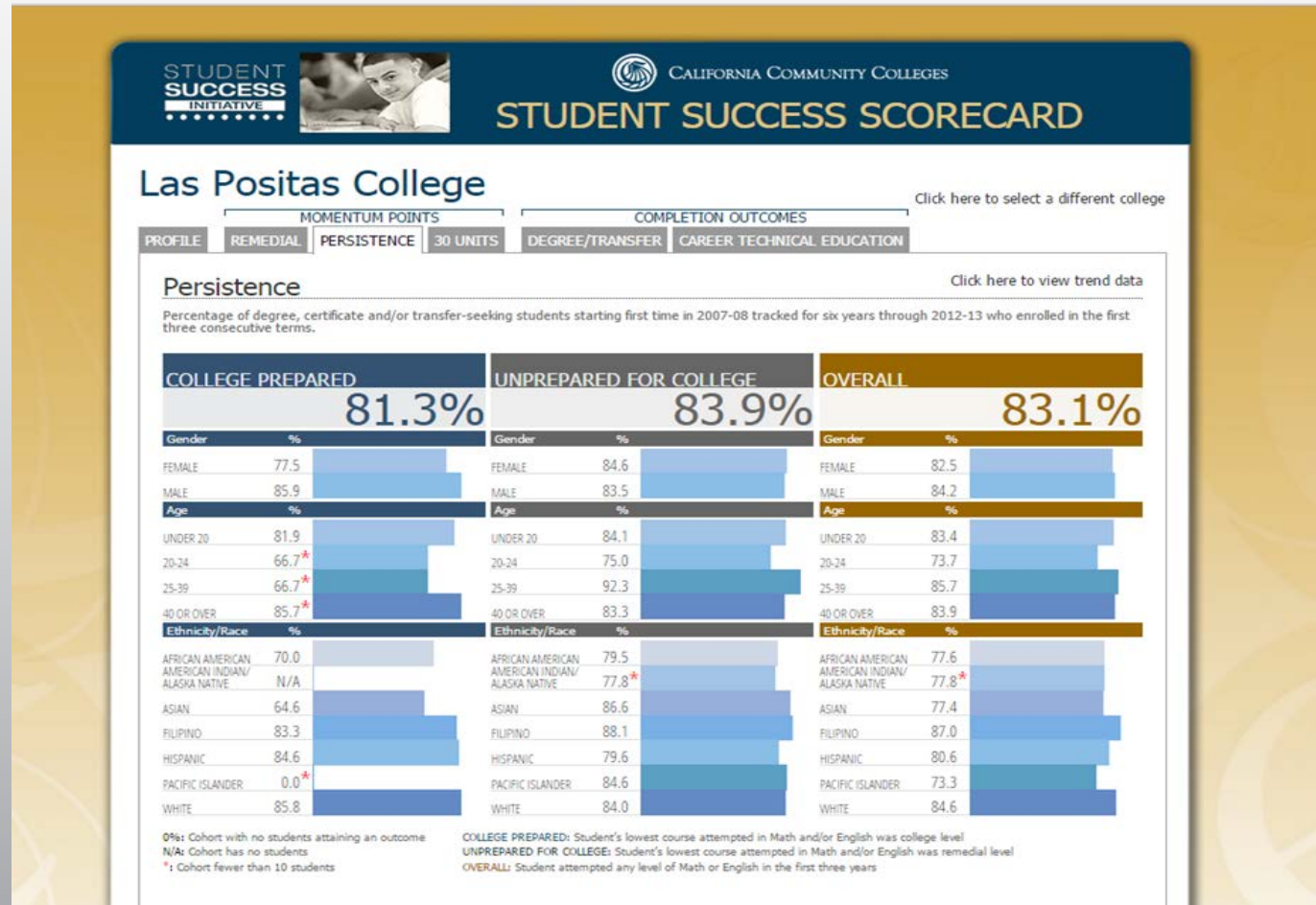

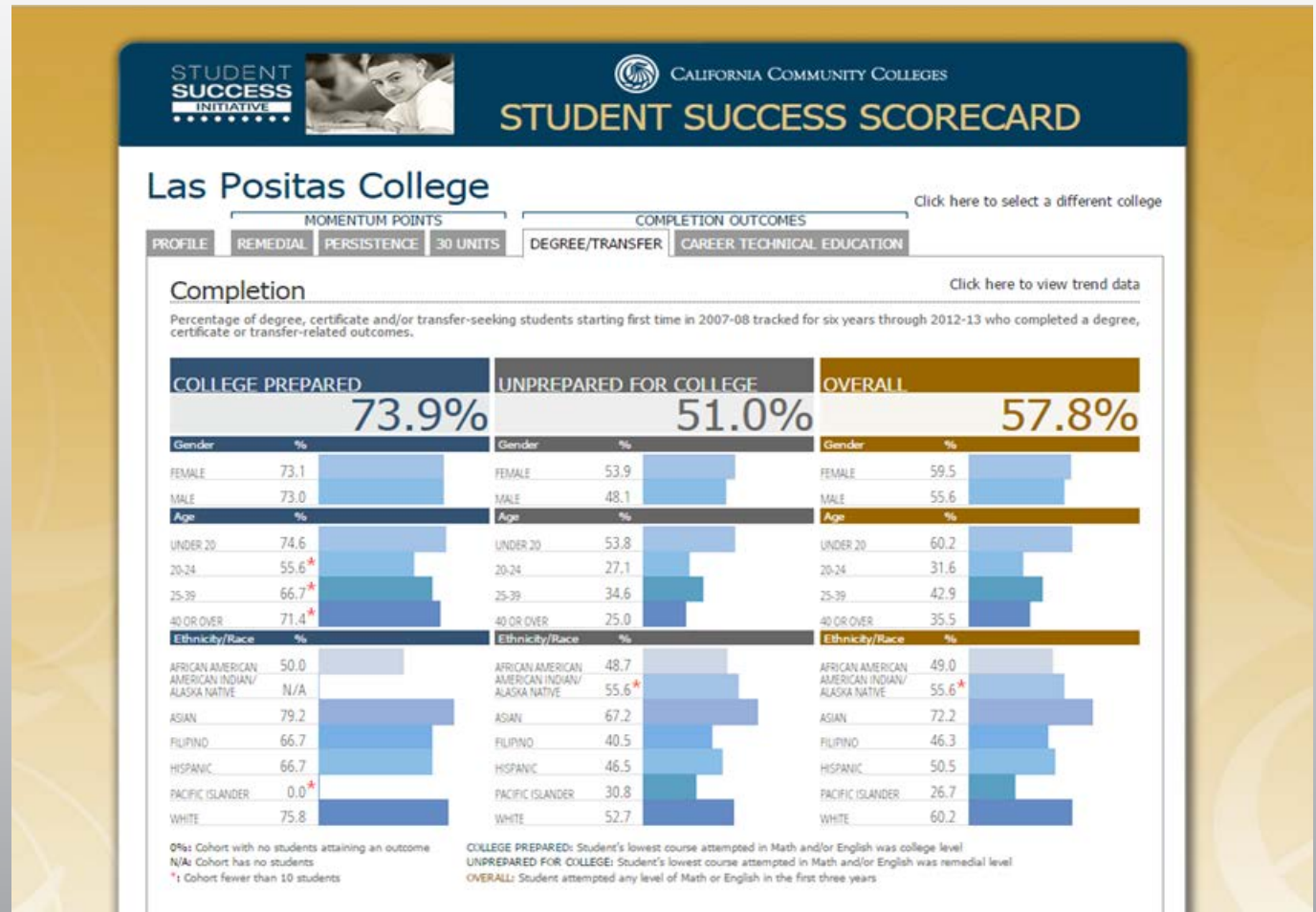

Student Success Scorecard



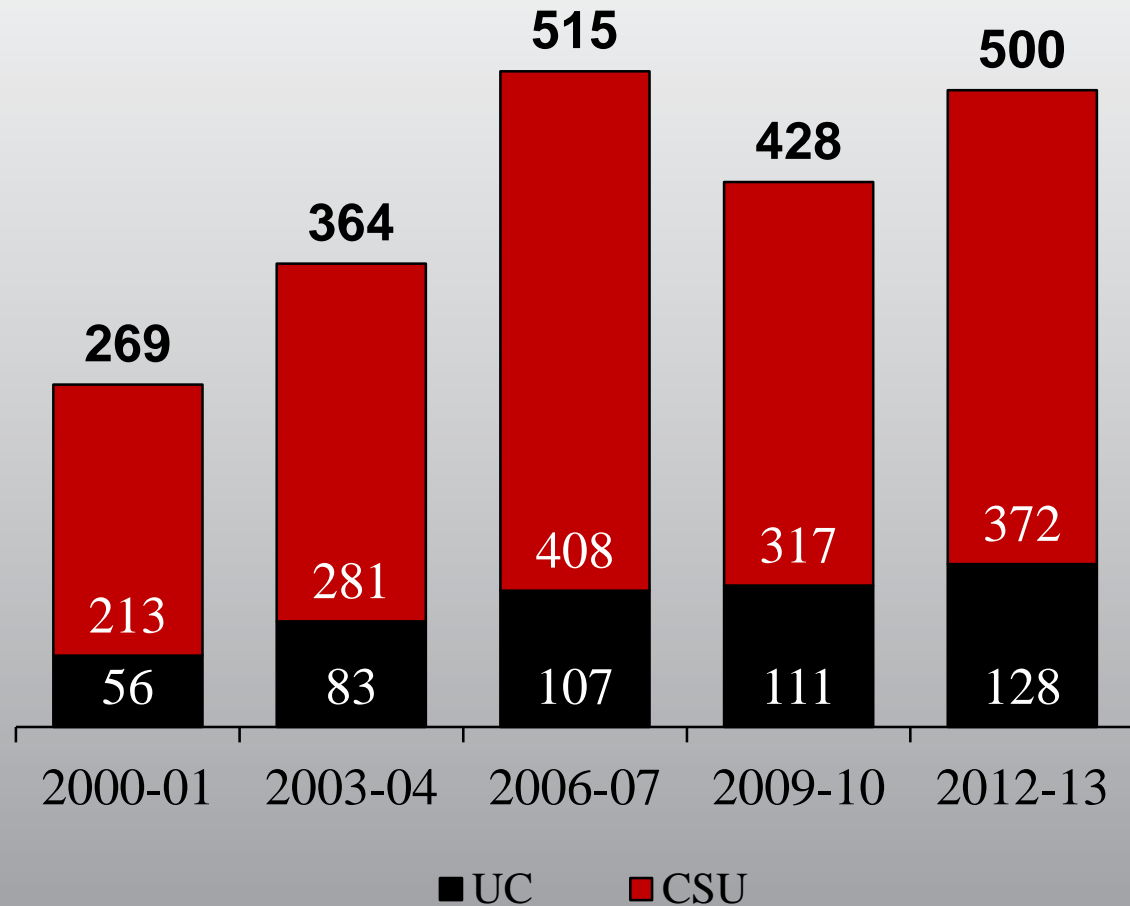

Transfer Success

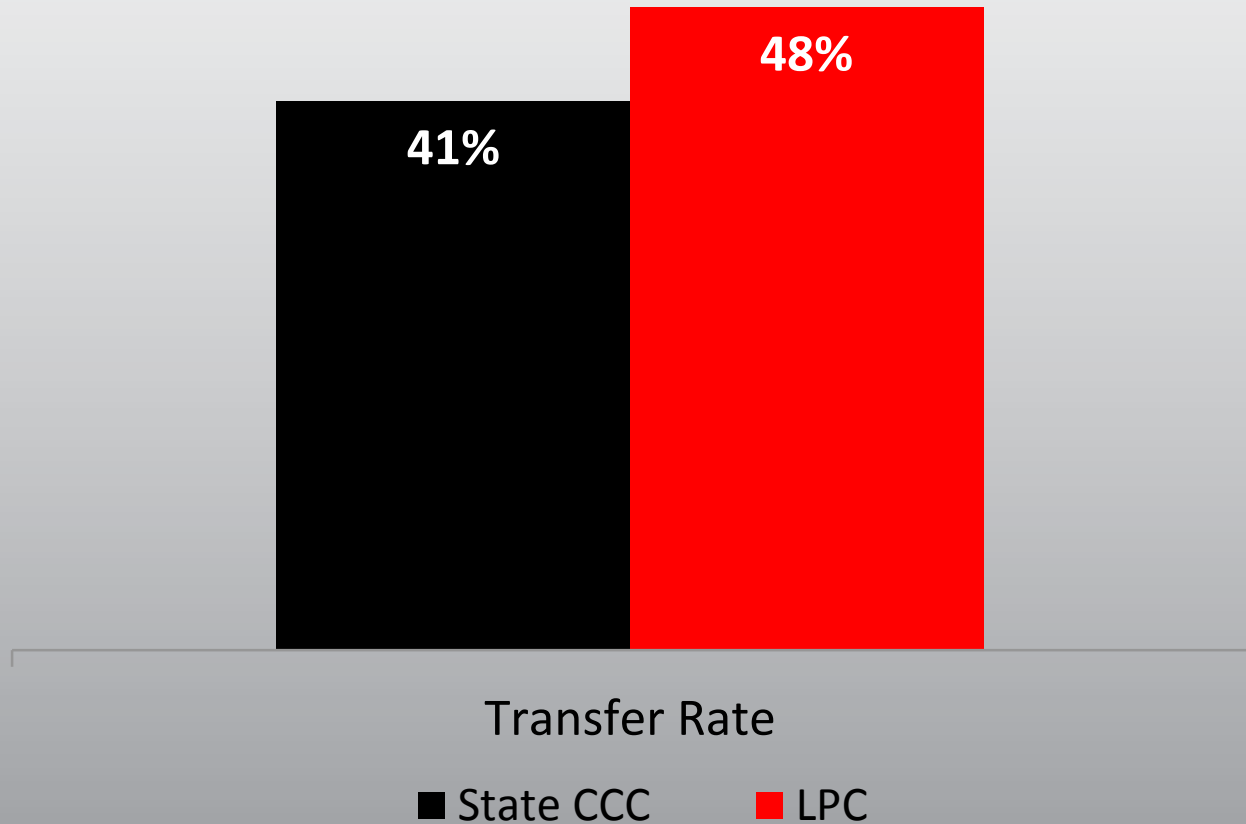
UC and CSU

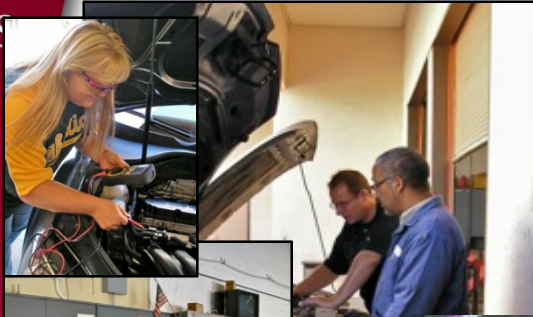

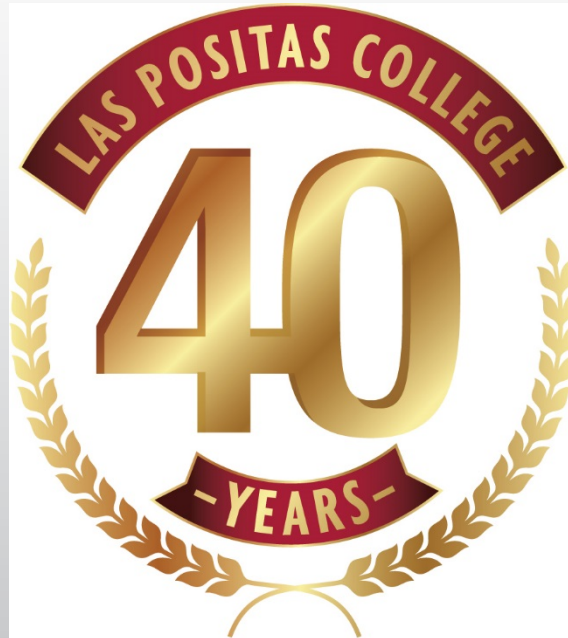
