RESOLUTION NO. 1801 In Support of Parking and Traffic Needs Study

WHEREAS, Las Positas students have been consistent in voicing concerns for increased parking;

WHEREAS, the representative student bodies of Las Positas and Chabot Colleges have met and discussed issues of mutual concern, agreeing transportation and parking to be a first priority;

WHEREAS, the representative student bodies of Las Positas and Chabot Colleges agree that the issues regarding parking, carpooling, mass transit, and green incentives should be studied and addressed;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Chabot-Las Positas Community College District has already shown interest in improving parking and transportation through increasing security, resurfacing and restriping lots, adding debit/credit card options for payment, increasing parking through an additional 200 parking stalls, and adding more EV charging stations;

WHEREAS, the Las Positas Student Mobility Initiative has enabled approximately 500 to 700 Las Positas College students ride daily free of charge;

WHEREAS, the students of Las Positas and Chabot Colleges are conducting a transportation survey to collect information from students on parking challenges and impacts on class attendance, especially during peak periods;

WHEREAS, students believe that consideration for increased parking and transportation should be included as an essential component of the Facilities Master Plan being developed as part of the June 7, 2016, \$950 million Measure A Chabot-Las Positas Facilities Bond passed and approved by the voters to upgrade and modernize campus facilities; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Las Positas College Student Government encourages the Chabot-Las Positas Community College District to continue in their efforts to meet transportation and parking needs and give strong consideration to student voices requesting improved parking in the upcoming Facilities Master Plan.
