

HONORS TRANSFER PROGRAM BASIC INFORMATION

Requirements for the LPC Honors Transfer Program

<u>For continuing students:</u> At least 12 units completed at LPC with a 3.5 or higher GPA, and eligibility for English 1A. It may be possible to enter with a lower GPA; see Dr. Klaschus.

<u>For new students entering from high school</u>: A 3.75 cumulative GPA and a copy of your high-school transcript.

You may apply at any time during the semester, but it's best to apply early in the term so you can get started on your honors projects.

Two Ways to Get Honors Credit

- 1. Any transferable course may become an honors course if you complete a substantial project in addition to the regular coursework. You will work one-on-one with a faculty member to design the project; both full and part-time faculty are eligible to mentor honors students.
- 2. Take one or more of the courses listed in the Course Schedule as having an embedded honors component.

The Benefits of the Honors Transfer Program

- Transcript designation for completion of an honors project in any transferable course;
- Personalized preparation for transfer to four-years schools;
- ♦ The chance to work one-on-one with Las Positas faculty and other highly-motivated students;
- ♦ The chance to present your academic work at a statewide honors research symposium to be held in Spring 2014 at UC Berkeley;
- Special recognition at graduation and on your diploma if you complete six honors activities.
