How to Register on CLASS-Web

- Log into CLASS-Web
- “Student Services” tab
- “Registration” link
- “Add/Drop or Withdraw from Classes” link
- Select the appropriate term and “Submit”
- Enter the 5-digit Course Registration Number (CRN) for each course that you want in each box provided (CRN number is the 5 digit number below next to the course name)
- “Submit Changes” button to register

You may choose between NBUS 210 or NBUS 200. Taking 5 of these courses will earn you the **Customer Service Certificate**.

To earn the **Small Business Management Certificate** you can choose 3 of the courses above, and must also take 2 courses in the Spring (Legal Aspects of Small Business – and – Developing Your Business Plan).

All courses are online, and are asynchronous.

Noncredit Course Eligibility

Anyone 18 years of age or older. Students holding F1/F2 and B1/B2 Visas are not allowed to enroll in noncredit classes. High school and Regional Occupation Program (ROP) students who may benefit from instruction and have permission from both their high school district or ROP, and their parent/guardian also may attend. High school students who fit into this category must follow the Concurrent Enrollment procedures.
