Registration for concurrent enrollment students begins May 15.

Classes are formatted in two parts: lecture (125 minutes, Monday - Thursday) and lab (120 minutes, Tuesday, and Thursday). A compass, protractor, and scientific calculator may be required for some sections of this course.

Your Registration Checklist

1. Log into [Class-Web](#) by entering your User ID (W#) and PIN
2. Select the "*Student Services*" tab at the top
3. Scroll down and select "Registration"
 - If you already know the CRN for your class, click on "*Add/Drop or Withdraw from Class*" then select "*Summer 2023*" in the drop down list for the term and submit. Next, enter the

5-digit Course Registration Number (CRN) for each course that you want to register for in each box provided.

- If you do not know the CRN for your class, click on “*Look Up Classes To Add*” then select “*Summer 2023*” in the drop-down list for the term and submit. Next, select “*Noncredit Math- LPC*” in the drop-down list, click “*Course Search*”, then click “*View Sections*” next to 256 Geometry.

4. Click “*Submit*” at the bottom of the page
