Good afternoon, Steering Committee Members, and Chairs of Students, Classified, and Academic Senates:

Please share the following updates with your respective divisions and committees.

- Successful outreach campaign through Ellucian Advise to students without comprehensive SEPs.
- Jared and Rachel (in District ITS) are making good progress on data dashboards for each Pathway and expect to have them completed soon.
- New legislation focused on student-parents (AB 2458) - investigating how to implement LPC. Main components are a student parent website with comprehensive financial aid, campus and community services for college student-parents. Will be collaborating with all programs at LPC that serve student-parents.
- We intend to apply for the State Chancellor's Program Mapper grant up to \$60,000. The grant funds can be used for institutionalizing Program Mapper and on-going maintenance due to curriculum updates.
