Accreditation

Accreditation is a uniquely American practice for:

- assuring institutional quality internally and externally
- ensuring educational effectiveness
- stimulating institutional quality improvement.

It is a peer review process.

It is a voluntary process, although...

The federal government, and most states, require institutions to be accredited in order to be eligible to receive and distribute public funds.

Obligations of an Accredited College

- To provide quality and effective education to students, enabling them to meet their goals;
- To assure public that quality education is provided which meets established standards of good practice and regional Standards;
- To constantly improve programs and services based on assessments.
- To meet all accreditation Eligibility Requirements,
 Accreditation Standards and Commission policies at all times.

Accreditation: The Process:

LPC has agreed to a review every 6 years

The internal evaluation = self evaluation report

The external evaluation = the team visit

Commission review and accreditation action

Continuous quality improvement based on recommendations.
