

LIVERMORE—Two Las Positas College students are finalists in an international contest honoring the best student journalism in the United States and Canada.

Tami Shepherd is a finalist in the Associated Collegiate Press 2015 Photo Excellence in the Feature Picture Category for the image on the left. It accompanied the story "My Beautiful Body," a look at the body positivity movement in Naked Magazine.

Jesus Mesina is a finalist in the ACP 2015 Design of the Year in the Illustration category. His drawing of Bill Paskewitz ran in the December 5, 2014 edition of The Express.





Shepherd is currently editor-in-chief of Naked Magazine and Photo Editor for The Express. Mesina is an illustrator for both Naked Magazine and The Express.

"I am thrilled that we are finalists in such a prestigious contest." Shepherd said. "We work so hard on the magazine and on the newspaper, and it means a lot for us to be recognized at this level." The ACP contest pits LPC students against the best student journalists on the continent at both two-year and four-year colleges. Shepherd is up against photographers from DePaul University, University of Oregon, University of Texas at El Paso, Midwestern State University, Mount Royal University, North Carolina State University, Richland College, Texas Tech University and Baylor.

Mesina is facing competition from illustrators at UCLA, the University of Miami, Iowa State University, University of Texas at El Paso, the Community College of Denver, Indiana University, Appalachian State University, Temple University and Eastfield College.

This year's contest marks the fourth time since 2010 that Las Positas College student journalists have been honored in ACP's ultra-competitive annual contest of two-year and four-year schools.

Former "Naked Magazine" writer and editor Brenda Cruz was recognized twice. In 2010, she won third place for best feature story and in 2012 finished second for Reporter of the Year.

In 2013, LPCExpressNews.com was a finalist in the Online Pacemaker contest and sixth place best in show at the ACP Convention in New Orleans.
