








LPC by the Numbers: Changing Demographics






LPC by the Numbers: Changing Demographics






LPC by the Numbers Headcount






LPC by the Numbers Headcount Down 13%





Impact of State Funding


LPC Course Capacity

 Passage avoids trigger cuts in January totaling \$5.2 million for the Chabot Las Positas
 Community College District.
 Averts statewide trigger cuts c
 - Averts statewide trigger cuts of \$338 million.





- Budget premised on passage -\$210 million (\$159 million deferral buy-down; \$50 million enrollment restoration
- REVENUES ALREADY "WEAVED" THROUGH CCC BUDGET





RESTRICTIONS/REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

- Proceeds shall NOT be used for salaries or benefits of administrators or any other administrative costs
- Districts must publish on their web site an accounting of how funds were spent
