

Governor's Budget Update 2017-2018

Increases for Growth & COLA, plus base augmentation

- \$79.3 million for 1.34% increased access
- \$94.1 million for 1.48% COLA
- \$23.6 million base increase, to cover increased operating expenses



New initiatives

- \$150 million to implement guided pathways
- \$20 million for innovation awards program
- \$6 million for an integrated, cloud-based library system
- All of the above are one-time funds
- \$10 million increase to the Online Education Initiative to provide statewide access to the initiative's Learning Management System



Ongoing Programs

- \$43.7 million for Physical Plant and Instructional Equipment approximately 30% of last year's level
- \$52.3 million for energy efficiency projects through Proposition 39
- COLA also provided to categorical programs including EOPS, DSPS and CalWORKs



Budget Process – next steps

- Legislative hearings throughout the spring
- May Revision in mid-May after income tax revenue level is known
- Final budget presented to Governor by Legislature no later than June 15
