# 6. Reports

• Chair's Report Craig Kutil

Craig Kutil stated that on Wednesday he attended the Assist Policy Advisory Committee meeting at the UCOP and on Friday he attended the Region 4 AO meeting. He will attend the Region 3 AO meeting on Friday, the Spring Regional Curriculum Meeting on March 15<sup>th</sup> and the NCIAC Meeting on March 22<sup>nd</sup>. At the Assist Policy Advisory Committee he motioned that all community colleges finish their submissions by mid-may into Assist, as was the previous policy for consistency. Also, they discussed some of the data corruption issues they have faced with the new Assist, however the new public site is much more user friendly. Craig has discussed with other AOs and our English department that requiring the 4 unit ENG 1AEX will require updating all of our degrees to reflect the increased GE requirement. Also, he has reached out to the CCC Academic Senate about how requiring the increased GE requirement would violate CSU Executive order 1100. He will keep the Curriculum Committee apprised of any updates.
