Kristina Whalen stated that she attended the CIO Conference last week in San Diego. The thesis for the conference was around "equity at our core". This included removing barriers to curriculum, specifically calculating noncredit distance education apportionment. Due to the complexity of this calculation, noncredit courses are not created or offered often as DE. There is an upcoming change to Title 5 to correct this issue. We will be moving to quarterly curriculum approvals at board, as requested by the Curriculum Chair. Craig Kutil clarified that this will allow the Curriculum Committee to have first readings at our last meeting of the semester that can still be approved by the board before the catalog.

The Chemistry and Physics UC Transfer degrees will move forward, despite there being disagreement between the UCOP and the Academic Senate. These transfer pathways do not use AA/AS GE, CSU GE, or IGETC, instead it is a subset of to IGETC requirements. While this will get students entrance, they will need to complete the remaining IGETC requirements when they transfer. It was suggested that this practice be instituted for our local AA/AS degrees. This will most likely be of the most benefit our Liberal Arts & Sciences AA students. This will be brought for first reading next meeting.
