After Friday's NCIAC meeting, I have some clarification. We will have to either cross-list courses to a new Ethnic Studies prefix or move them to that new prefix. I think cross-listing is a better idea, since it will give the courses more visibility. Students will be able to satisfy Area F with either prefix. I will be updating the CSU GE-Breadth sheet for Fall 21 to show Area F. The requirements for approval are the prefix (or cross-listing) and a preponderance of evidence that the courses will meet the listed Core Competencies (Measurable Objectives). Specifically, the reviewers want to see the Content and Assignments reflect the Core Competencies – i.e., Content and Assignments related to the Measurable Objectives. The Core Competencies don't have to be written verbatim into the Measurable Objective section, but they should

be something close. Updated COR's will need to be on the November 30th Curriculum Committee agenda for first reading.
