- Visual cue/badge for action items Courses, Programs, Course Block Library (GE's)
- Changes are auto-saved, but you get a warning message too
- -We can ask CNET for more advanced customization; we don't have to do so much work (95% they can do with the base setup)
- -CB validation rules built in Can link to SLOs too. Under Codes: There's even a spot for SLO approval date.
- -Migrating in "a reasonable time period" --> About 6 months
