- Note that when you're looking at courses, equity language we're concerned with is what's in the course outline and catalog description.
- Common Course Numbering begins! COMM, ENGL, POLS, PSYC, & STAT ("C" in front of the course number stands for "Common course number")
- Note that he won't know if they can remove the "Methods of formative and summative evaluation are" [scripted language] from CORs until Nov.
- Process: For cross-listed courses, we only need to update 1 (not 2). Source is updated; Chair syncs in CNET after source goes thru approval.
- DE: Evaluation methods should fit the regular evaluation methods piece
