Draft AP 6750 on Parking: Shared the Draft AP 6750 on Parking. Updates on Policies and Administrative Procedures on parking. College has moved to the digital parking system. An individual's license plate is their permit number. Sharing the updated language regarding the new digital parking system discussing the new system and how head in parking is the only way the permit can be read. Next update is the Electric Vehicle Charging Zone section that mentions that charging is free of cost which is not going to be the case at a future date. Blue font is the newly added policies to the document discussing the newly regarding policies of the EV Charging station. One of the updates is the fees that will be enforced at a later date. These fees will help fund the repairing of these stations. New items all includes that the fee will be based on a "per KWH rate" and a valid parking permit is required.
