Caring Campus 101

- An intentional effort to make students feel welcome and a sense of connectedness to your college
- Engages the underutilized classified professionals who are typically missing from student success efforts
- Helps classified professionals connect with one another and with other employee groups to create a positive college environment
- Creates behavior change that influences culture change across campus
- Causes the college to reexamine policy barriers to student success



Classified Professionals and Caring Campus

- Classified professionals are often the first contact a student has with LPC
- This interaction can set the stage for student success
- IEBC has a proven method for engaging with professional staff to create a Caring Campus that ensures they are deeply involved in student success



Behavioral Commitments

IEBC coaches engage with classified professionals in coaching sessions. Classified professionals from all student-facing departments and divisions are invited to attend as well as others as the college may decide. Over the course of these coaching sessions, classified professionals are oriented to the Caring Campus initiative and identify the behavioral commitments they will make regarding interacting with students and strengthening their connection to the college.


