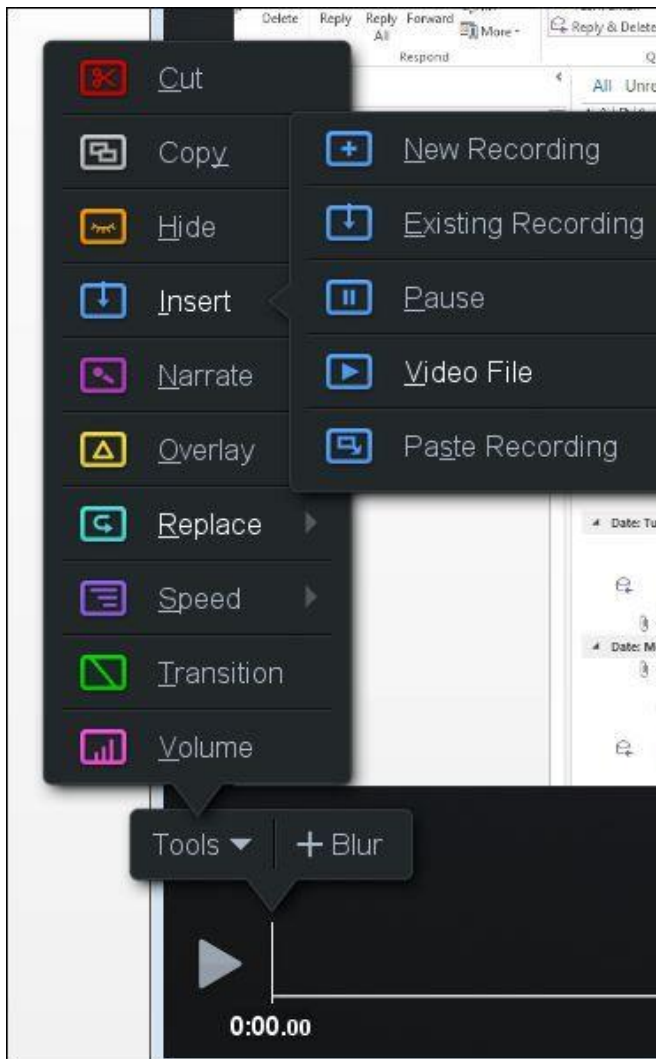

Re-Edit a Studio Video

1. Click on **Studio** on the global navigation.
2. Click on **Record**
3. Select **Screen Capture**.
4. After the screen capture software opens, click the red **Rec** button.
5. Wait for the countdown, and then click the blue **Pause** button to pause the recording. The recording doesn't have to be more than a couple seconds in length.
6. Click **Done**.
7. Click on the **Edit** button. This will bring up the online interface to start editing your video and adding other elements to it such as images, sound, videos, lines, arrows, etc.
8. In the **Tools** menu (shown below), select **Insert >> Video File**. This is where you'll have to choose a video file from your computer that you want to include in this video. (The **Existing Recording** option will not show you existing videos you've already uploaded to your My Uploads area of Studio. This option is for exiting recordings you've made using this screen capture tool.)

Canvas Studio is a video recording tool as well as a place to collect your favorite videos from YouTube or videos you may have on file already and want to upload to a Canvas course.

But a unique feature of Canvas Studio is that these videos can become an engaging communication tool that allows instructors and students to actively collaborate through the video recording timeline by adding questions or commentary for students to participate in as they are watching the video.

There is also a quiz feature, where you can create a video quiz along the video timeline, the video will pause showing a variety of question options you place on the timeline, and the best part is that it will appear in the gradebook.

One more amazing feature I must mention is about the [analytics in Studio](#). You (the instructor) can see who viewed or not viewed the video, down to details of how much they viewed or what parts of the video they may have skipped.

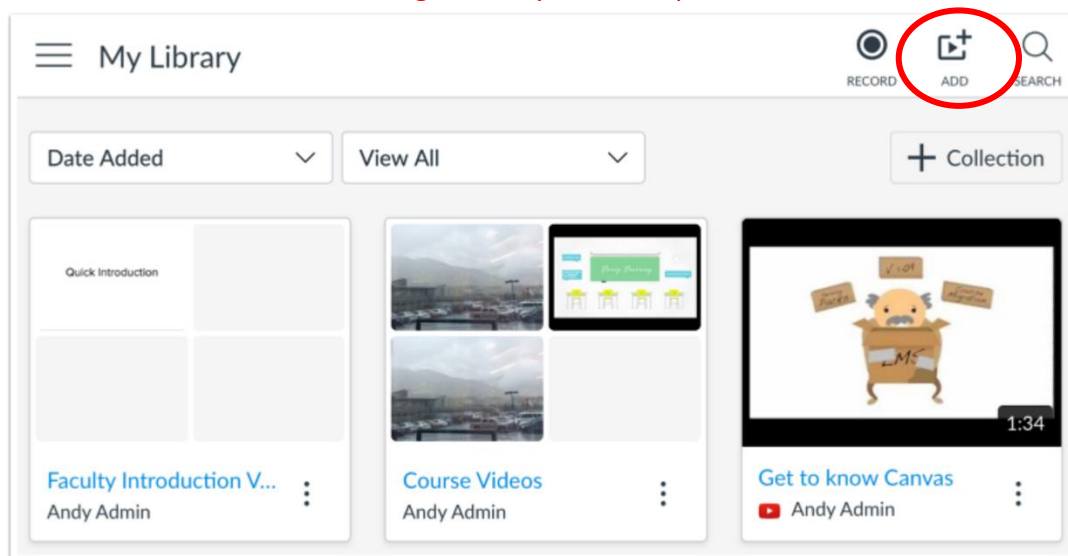
Accessing Studio in Canvas:

- Global Navigation – shows all videos and collections
- Course Navigation – shows only videos you bring into the course

Adding videos:

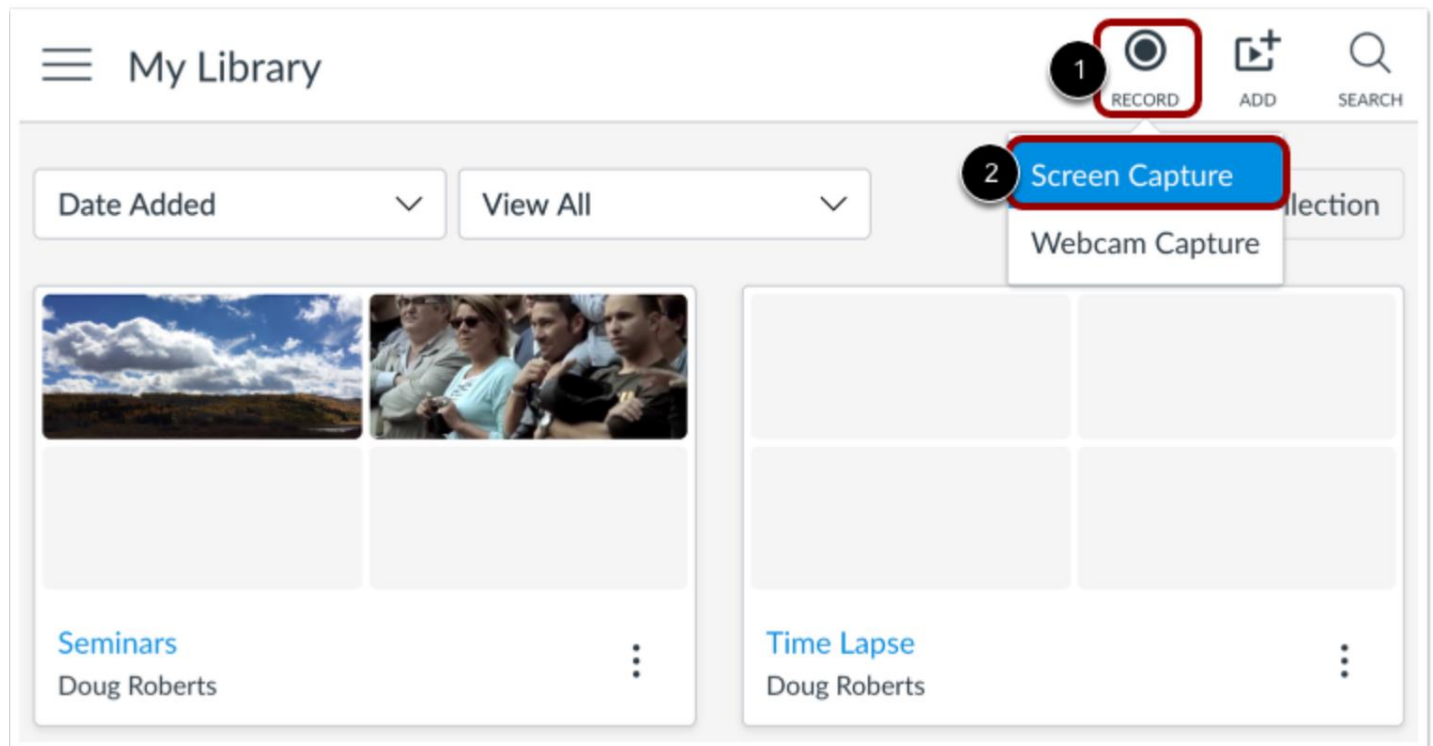
Let's start of by looking at how to build your collection.

- Upload files – audio or video
- YouTube – **does not bring over any closed captions**

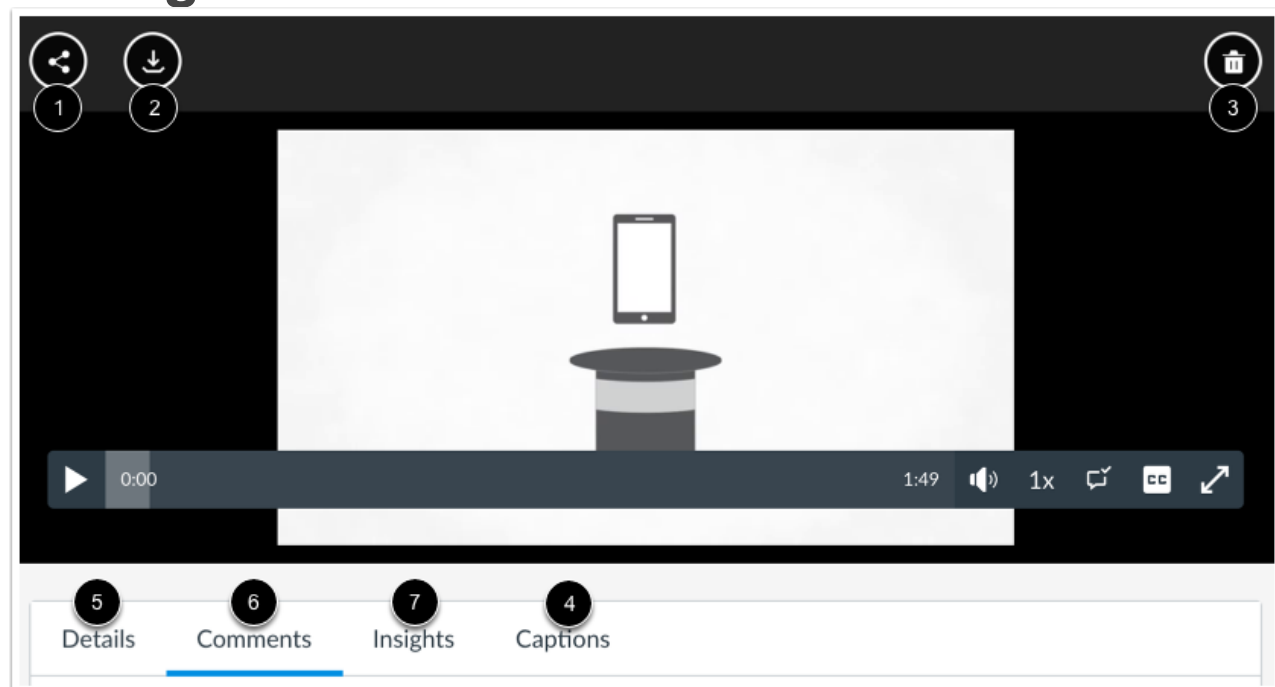


Recording a video:

Manage Media



When you add/upload media, you have access to all controls and settings. You can [share the media](#) or [get a public link or embed code](#) [1], [download the media](#) [2], [delete the media](#) [3], [add captions](#) [4], and [edit details and tags](#) [5].

Once users view your media, you can view their comments [6] and review [user analytics](#) [7].

Videos: [Captioning](#)

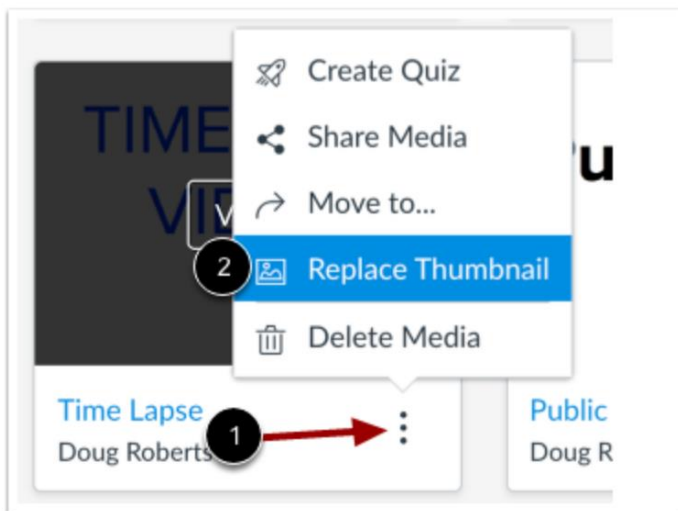
To generate or upload captions, click the **Captions** tab.

- Request captioning – 85% accurate
 - Once caption is completed you will receive an email to review, edit and post.
- Upload – SRT or VTT
 - These are captioning formats can be uploaded to a video in Studio. You made need to generate a caption file as well as edit a caption file before you upload it to Studio. Below are some resources to accomplish this.

Replace, Delete, Move to, Share, Create Quiz



Locate the video. Then click the **Options** icon [1] and click the **Replace Thumbnail** link [2].

Create a new Thumbnail image using:

- **Canva** - www.canva.com
- **PowerPoint** – create a slide in PPT and then “Export” as an image file type – “jpg” as seen in this example below shows.
