

# What can student success teams be?


Success Teams elements can include:

- Aligned with Academic and Career Pathways or stand alone

# Santa Ana College Success Team

Seven Goals for their students:

- Complete English and math in their first year
- Persist from Fall to Spring semester
- Receive support to complete their education goals, especially those close to completion
- Participate in program orientation
- Establish a mentor relationship with one faculty lead
- Complete a Success Team self-assessment
- Engage in early field work experience

# Mira Costa College Success Team

Goals for their students:

- All students complete Ed Plans
- Contact each student 3 times per year
  - Training for campus employees on success team support
  - Script for contacting students
- Student peers hired that specialize in accessing resources and/or career development support

# Diablo Valley College Success Team

Launched pedagogy inquiry teams

- Team of faculty aligned to each academic and career community
- 100% of the focus is on improving instruction
