What types of online classes are available?

At Las Positas, we offer fully and partially online courses that fit your unique needs:

Asynchronous

Need the ultimate flexibility? Take fully online classes with no required meetings. Log into Canvas to connect with your instructor and classmates! You'll find coursework with regularly scheduled due dates.

Tip: Sections start with "A" in the schedule.

Synchronous

Engage with your instructor and classmates in real-time, online. Sign up for online classes with live sessions via Zoom on scheduled days and times.

Tip: Sections start with "S" in the schedule.

Combination

Get the best of both worlds! Participate in scheduled live Zoom sessions and complete additional activities on your own in Canvas.

Tip: Sections start with "B" for both synchronous + asynchronous in the schedule.

HyFlex

Customize your experience! HyFlex courses give you flexibility to choose how to attend each class - in person or online. Online options may include attending class on Zoom or completing work on Canvas.

Tip: Sections start with "HF" in the schedule.

Hybrid

Balance on-campus and online learning. Attend some inperson meetings at LPC, while completing other coursework online at your convenience.

Tip: Sections start with "H" in the schedule.

On Campus

Of course, you are always welcome to attend classes on our beautiful campus, even if you consider yourself mostly an online student.

Tip: Sections start with "D" for daytime or "E" for evening in the schedule.



Zonemail

 Student email you'll check for important messages from the college (counseling, financial aid, etc.) + how you'll access Google tools like Docs and Slides.

MyPortal (ClassWeb)

 Where you'll register for classes, access official records/grades, etc.

Canvas

 Where you'll participate in your courses, communicate with your instructor + classmates, and use lots of other innovative technologies – like Hypothesis, Pronto + Zoom!

- A link to log into Canvas is at the top of any LPC website page.
- Click "Online Learning" for tutorials and support.
- You'll also find a link to Canvas on MyPortal - but please note: your Canvas password is different than your MyPortal password...more on that next!






Practice: First time Canvas Log-in



- Username: W number
- Password: first 2 letters of your first name, first 2 two letters of your last name (all lowercase), followed by the last 4 digits of your W number
 - **Ex**: Maria Valdez, W98765432, would enter password mava5432.






Your Canvas Dashboard



- Your Dashboard will show cards for:
 - Academic & Career Pathways (support course)
 - Other optional support shells, sometimes used by Student Clubs and groups on campus
 - Most important: classes you registered for (once the semester starts)
 - Plus, a helpful "To Do" list





Canvas Global Navigation



Account

 Set notification preferences and make updates to your profile (ie, change your password, add pronouns, add a bio, etc.)

Calendar

Great way to stay organized (if instructors using due dates)

Inbox

Dedicated communication for you, your instructors + classmates

Studio

Video-recording tool

Help

Canvas Student Guides + 24-7 Chat Support

Pronto


Instant Messaging tool for you, your instructors + classmates





Top Tips for the 1st Week



Check your Zonemail

o Many instructors use Zonemail to send a welcome letter ahead of the term with tips to get started.

Log into Canvas on the first day of the semester

 While online classes are often flexible, you will have regular due dates, and you don't want to miss early discussions + assignments!

Block out enough time to complete coursework

 Online courses require just as much time as on campus classes. While you may save time traveling to and from campus, you'll still need to block off enough time for each course
