**Concurrent Enrollment:** A special admit student currently enrolled in K-12.

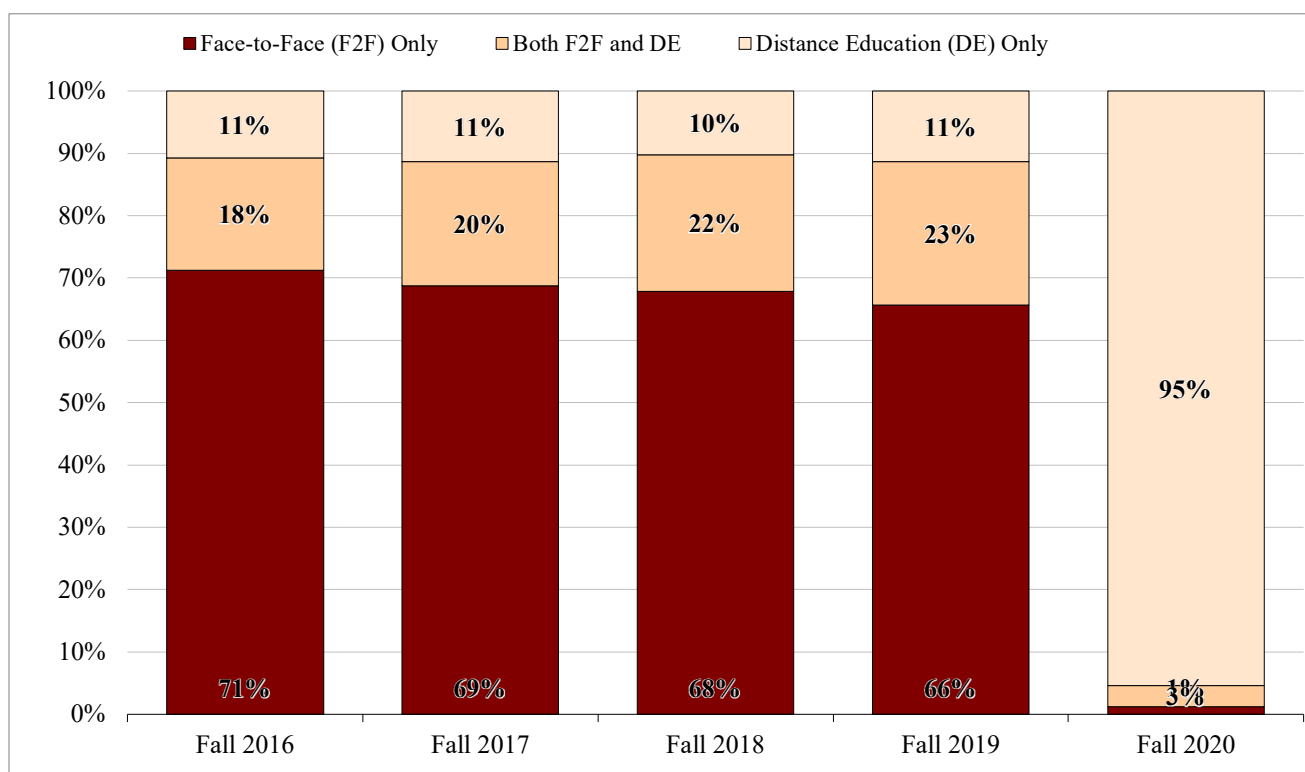

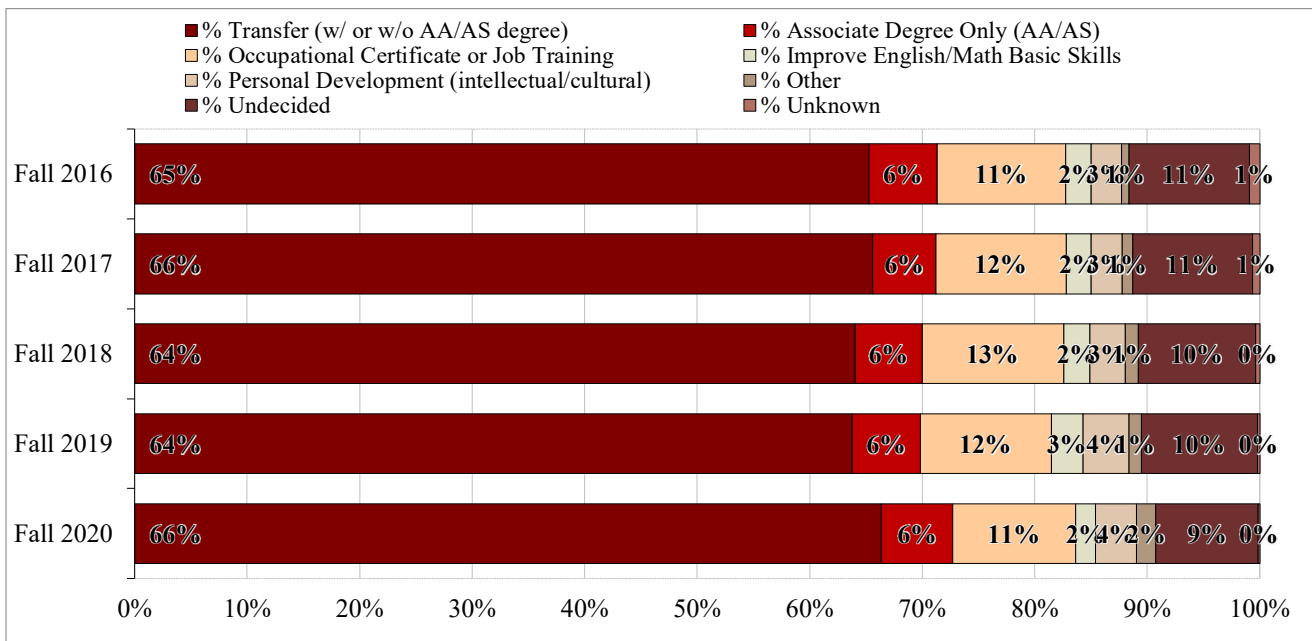

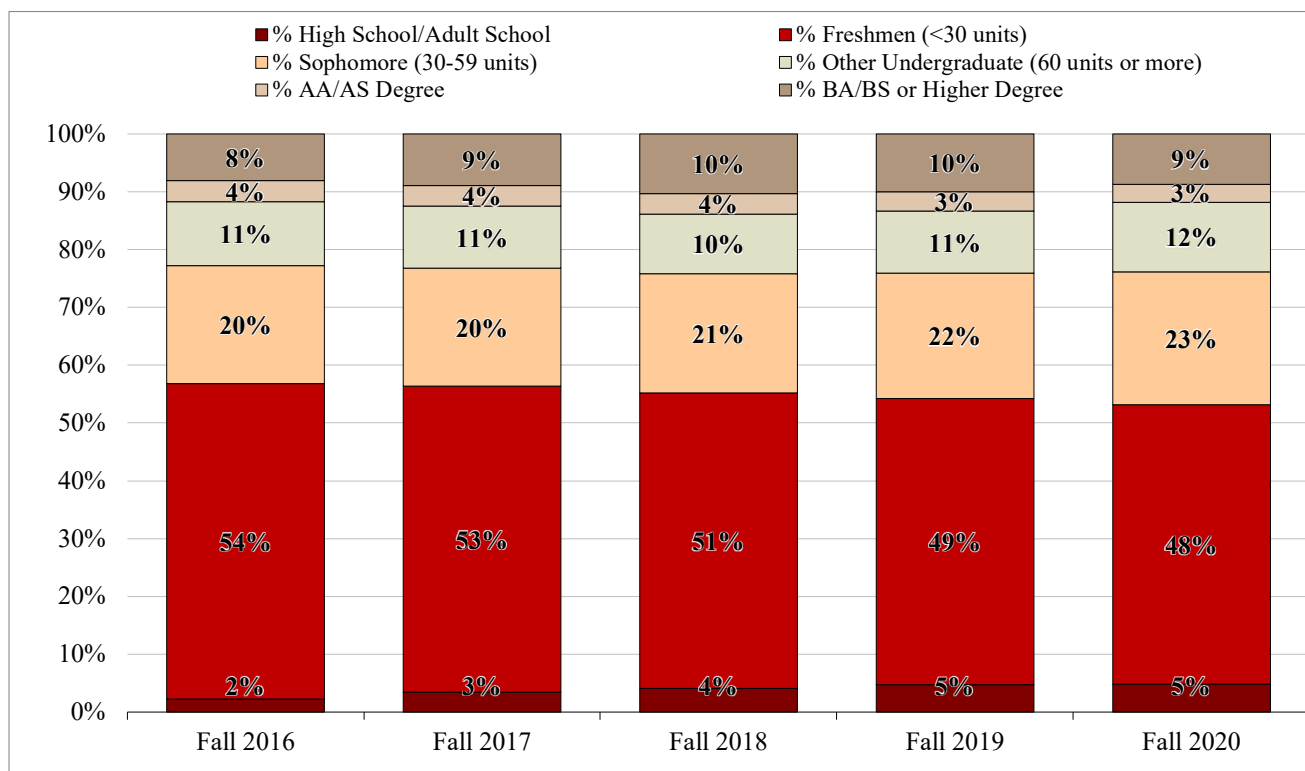
**Personal Development:** Students taking courses for intellectual and/or cultural development.
