SURVEY METHODOLOGY

- Random Stratified Sampling
- Online & In-person
- Oversampled to adjust for response rates
- Administered: Oct. 30th - Nov. 10th

SURVEY RESPONSE

Response Rate: 30.1 %
(722 Responses)

Sample Composition:

- 41% Online
- 59% In-Person

Actual Enrollments:

- 57% Online
- 36% In-Person
- 7% Other



SURVEY DEMOGRAPHICS

Survey Sample is slightly...

- Younger
- more transfer oriented
- more Full-time
- less Financial Aid utilization
- Less males (40% vs 45%)

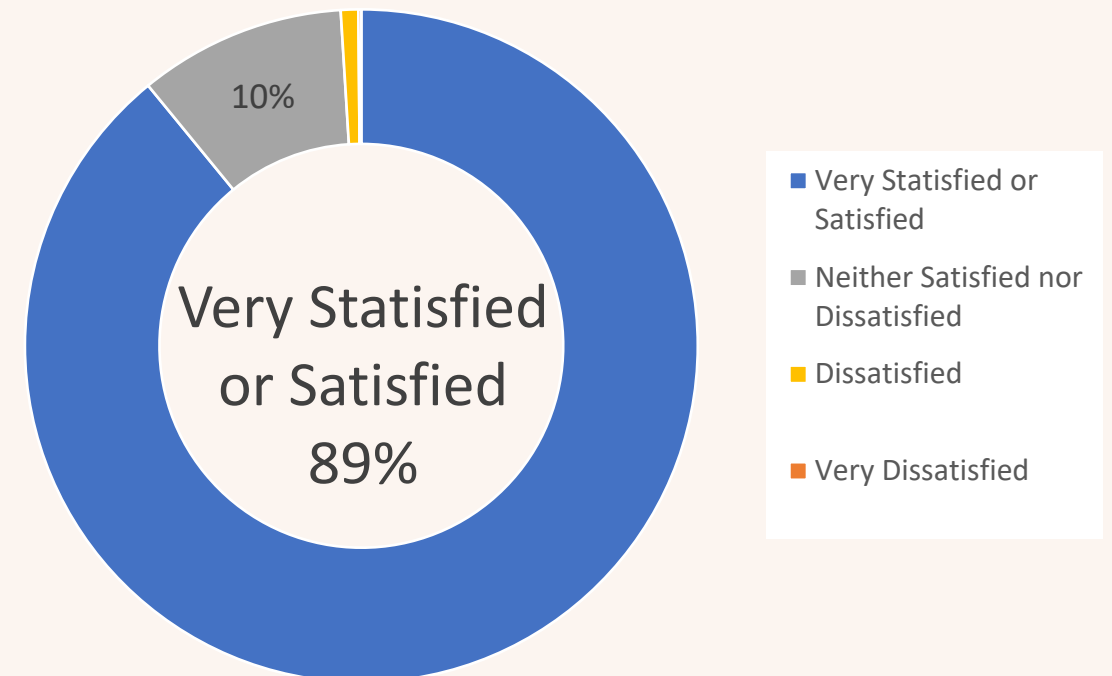

Overall Experience at LPC





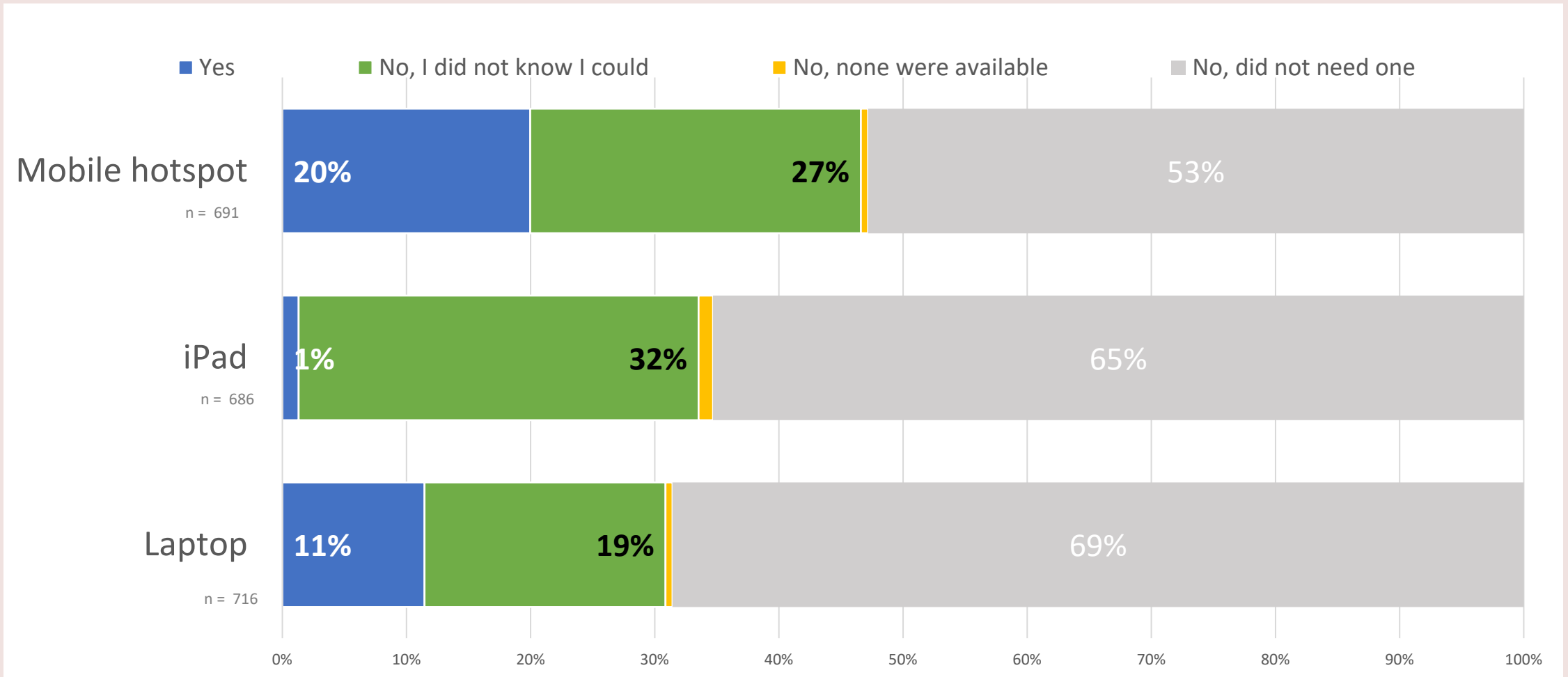
HIGHLIGHTS: TECHNOLOGY

- Majority use their own laptop for classes
- Opportunity to increase access to tablets
- Increase awareness of devices in the Library

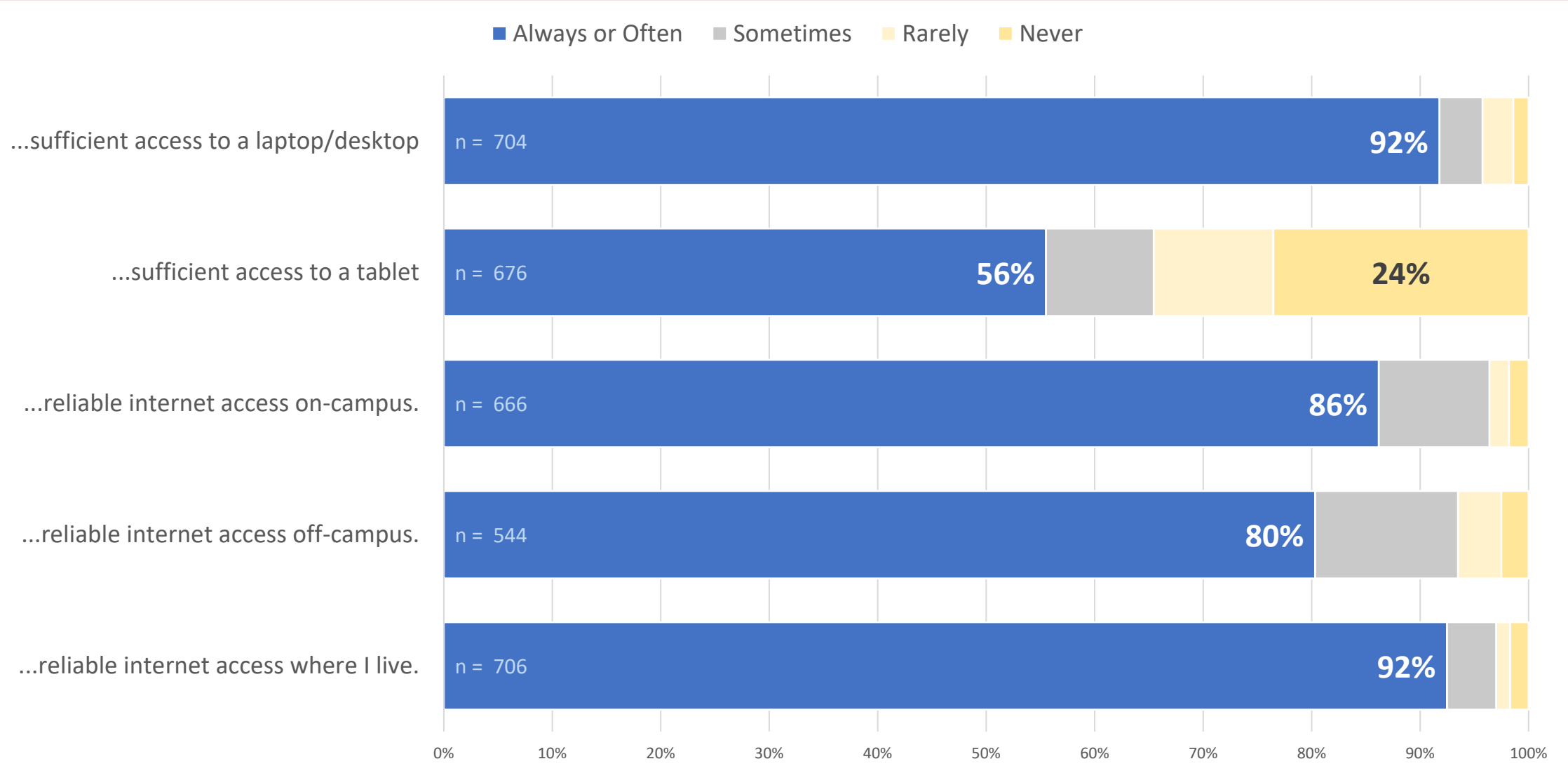

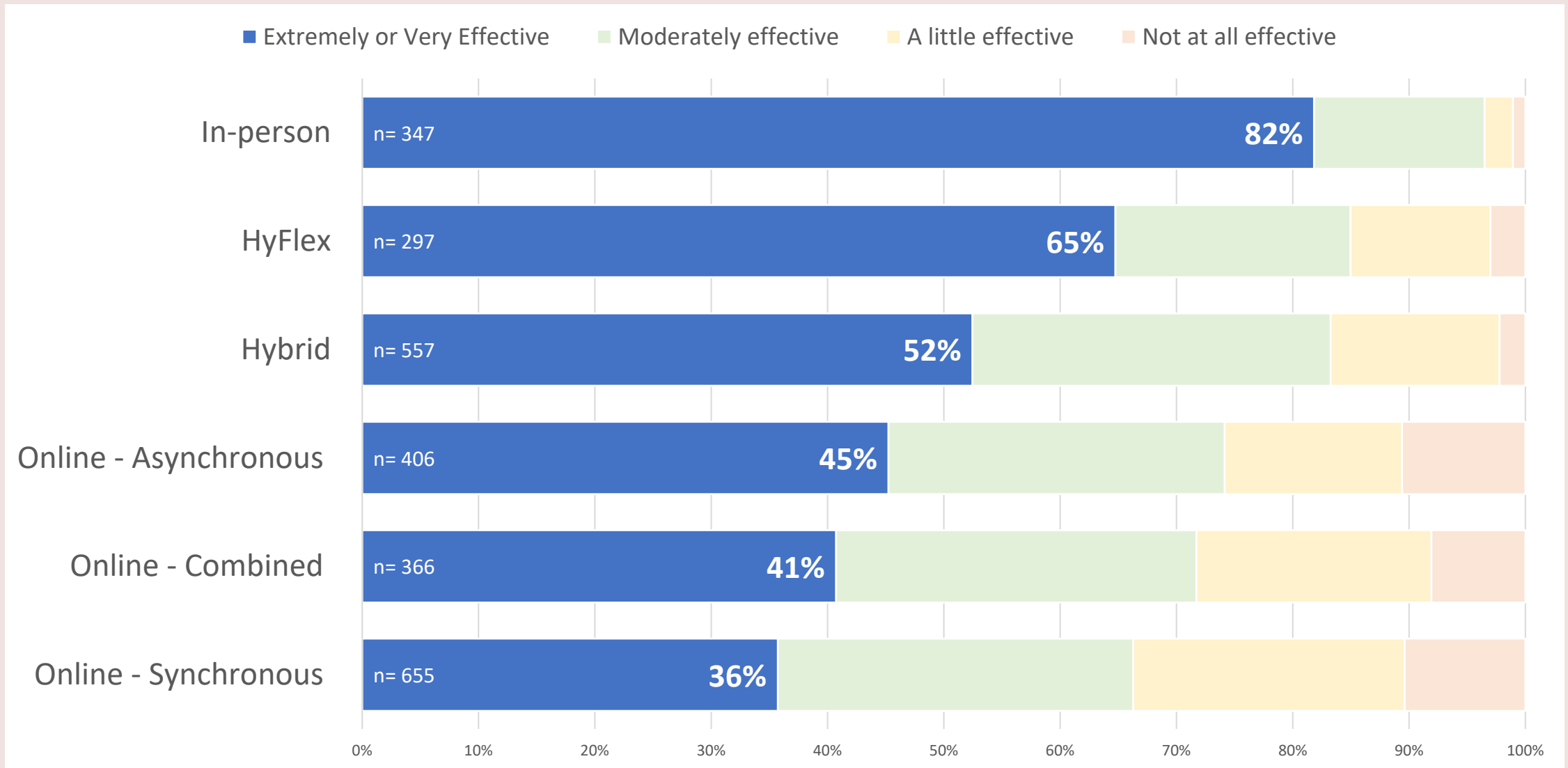
- Most Helpful Features:

Which course features have been most helpful in learning the course material (check all that apply):

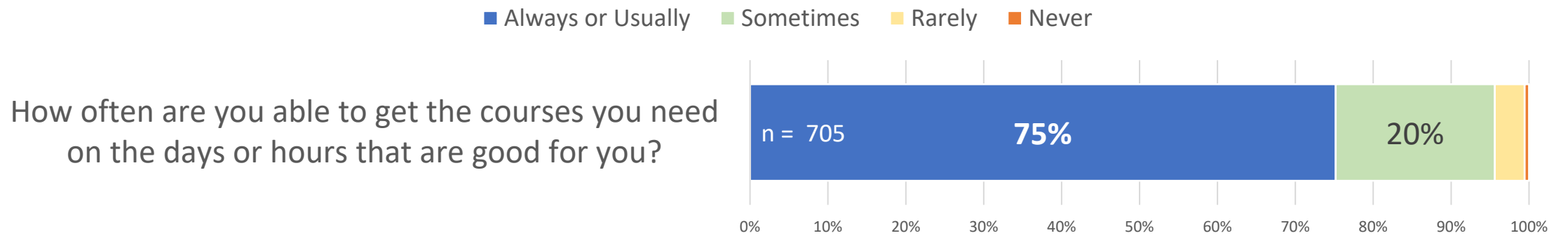

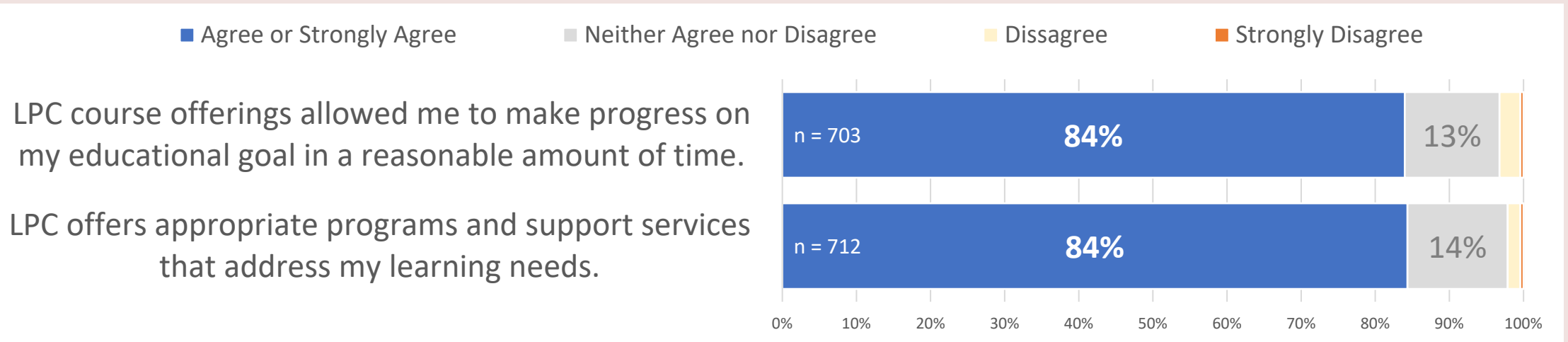




HIGHLIGHTS: PROGRAMS & PATHWAY

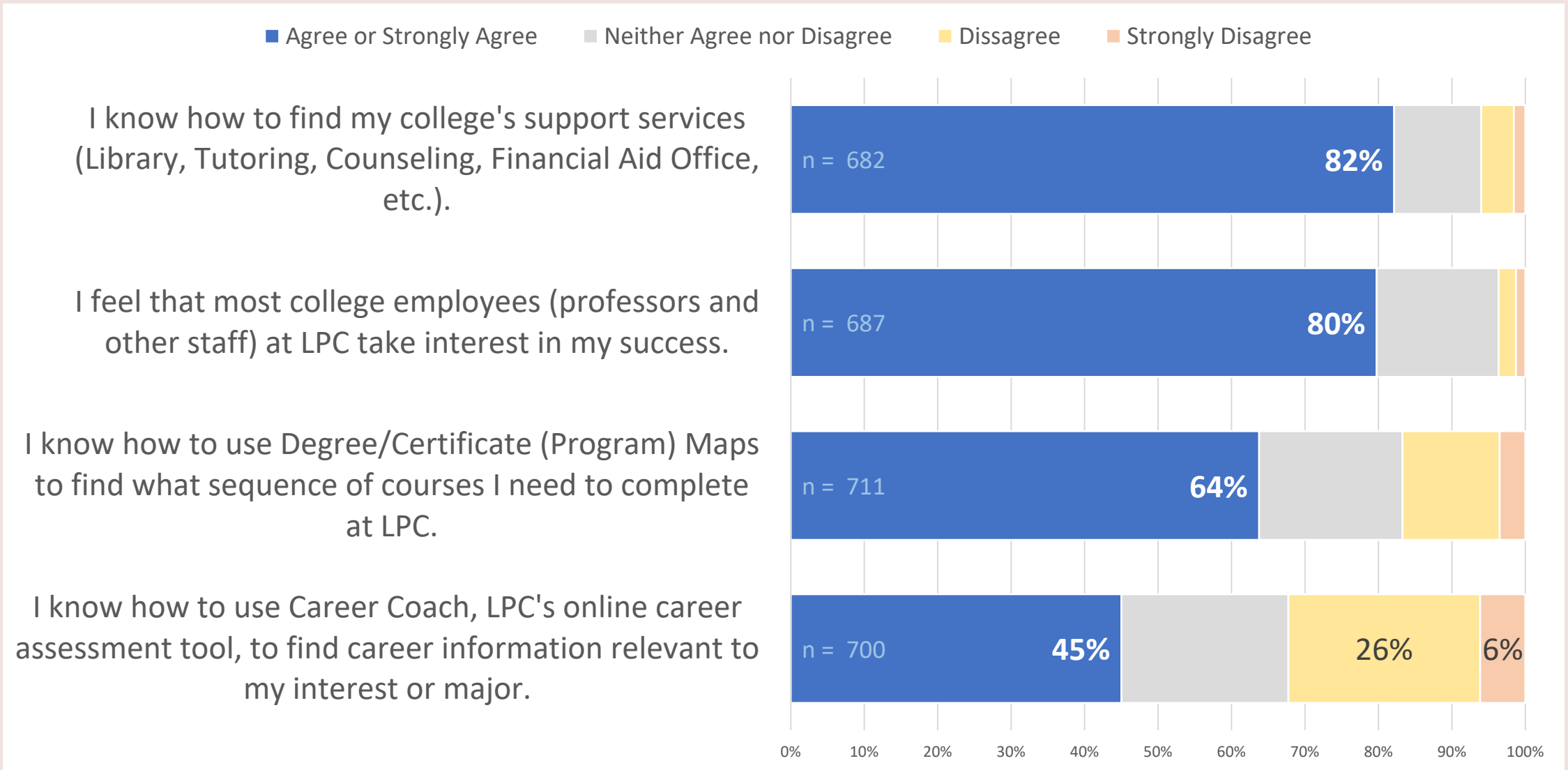
- More than 8 out of 10 students thought:
 - Course offerings allowed them to make progress
 - LPC offers appropriate programs & support services
 - Knew how to find support services
- Opportunity to increase awareness of Career Coach and Program Maps, and transfer guidance/know-how

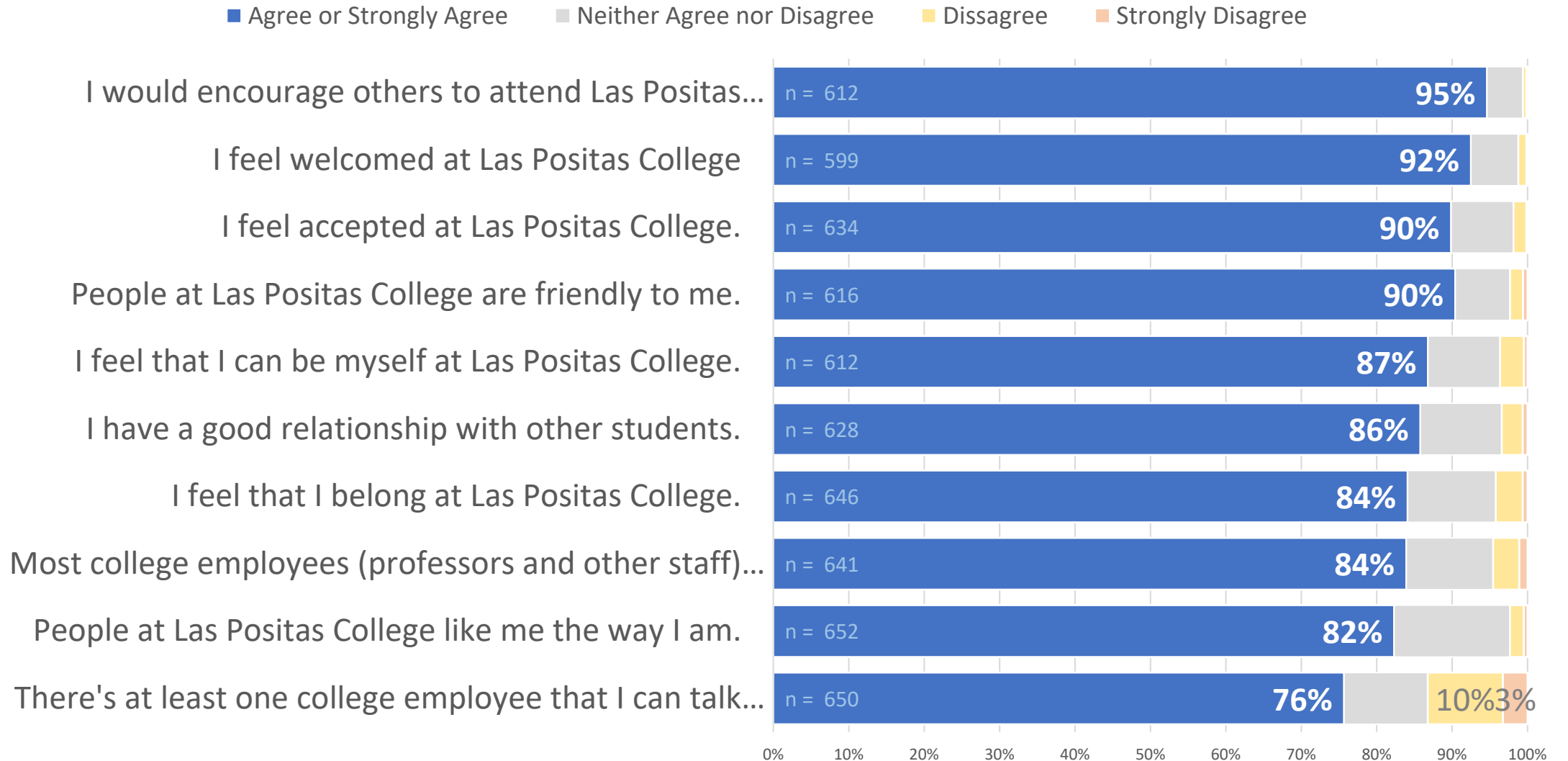




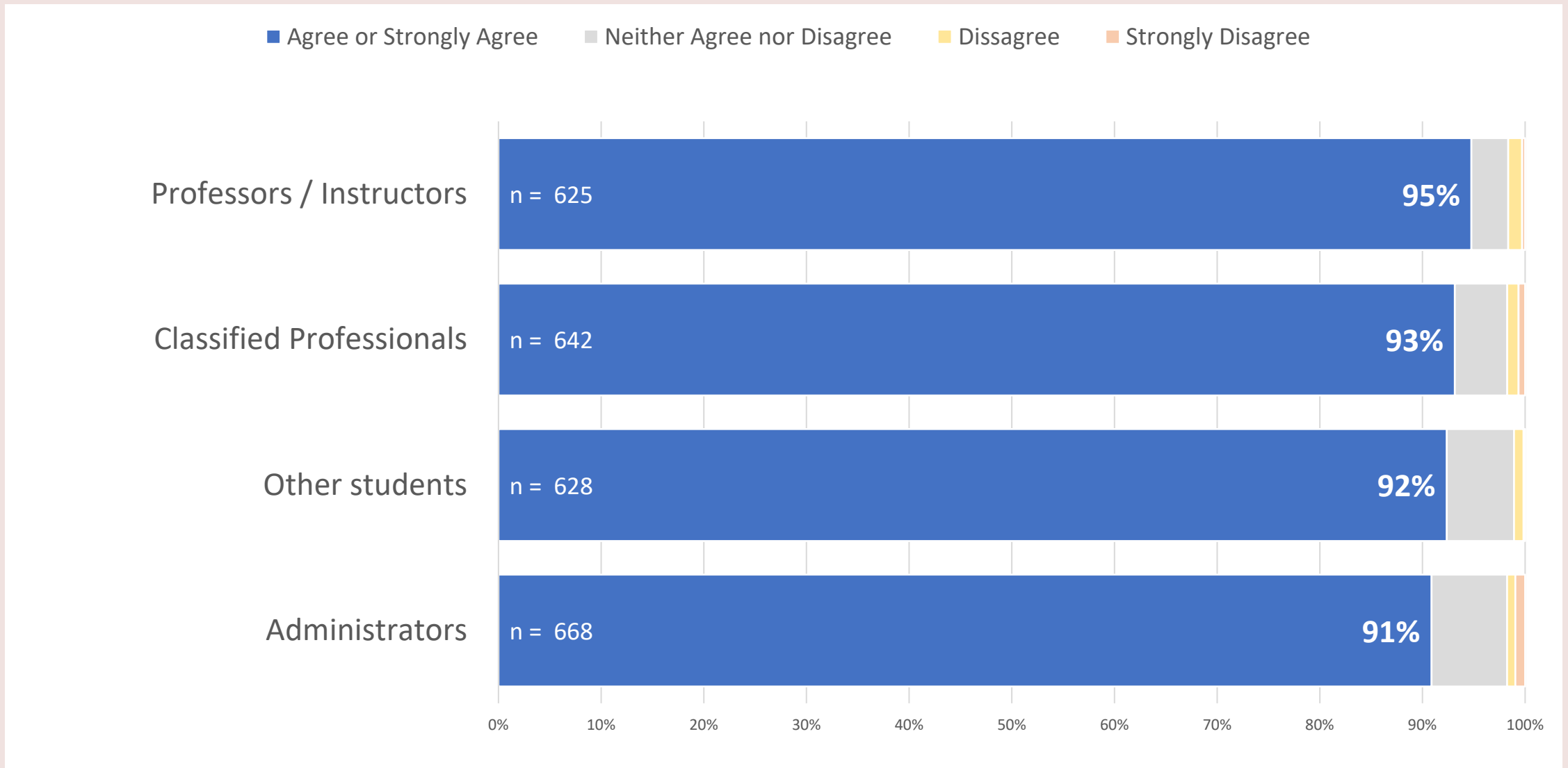
HIGHLIGHTS: CAMPUS CLIMATE

- Majority of students:
 - Would encourage others to attend
 - Feel welcomed & accepted
 - Feel people are friendly at LPC
 - Feel treated with respect
 - Feel there is respect for differences (some opportunities to improve respect for differences in religious / political beliefs)
- Opportunity to improve approachability or availability of college employees
- Some notable differences in responses among race-ethnicity groups

CAMPUS CLIMATE

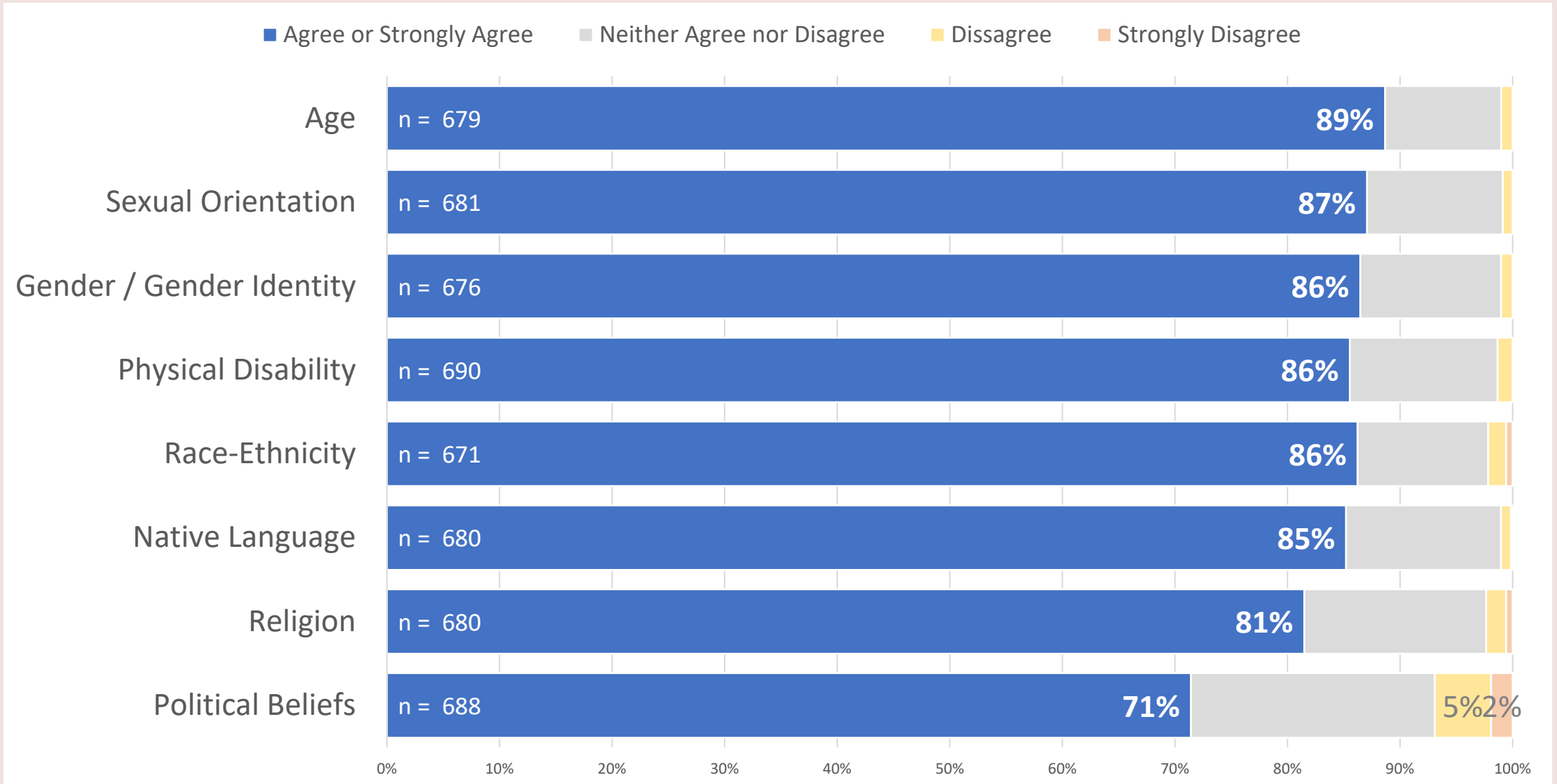


STUDENTS TREATED WITH RESPECTED

RESPECT FOR DIFFERENCES



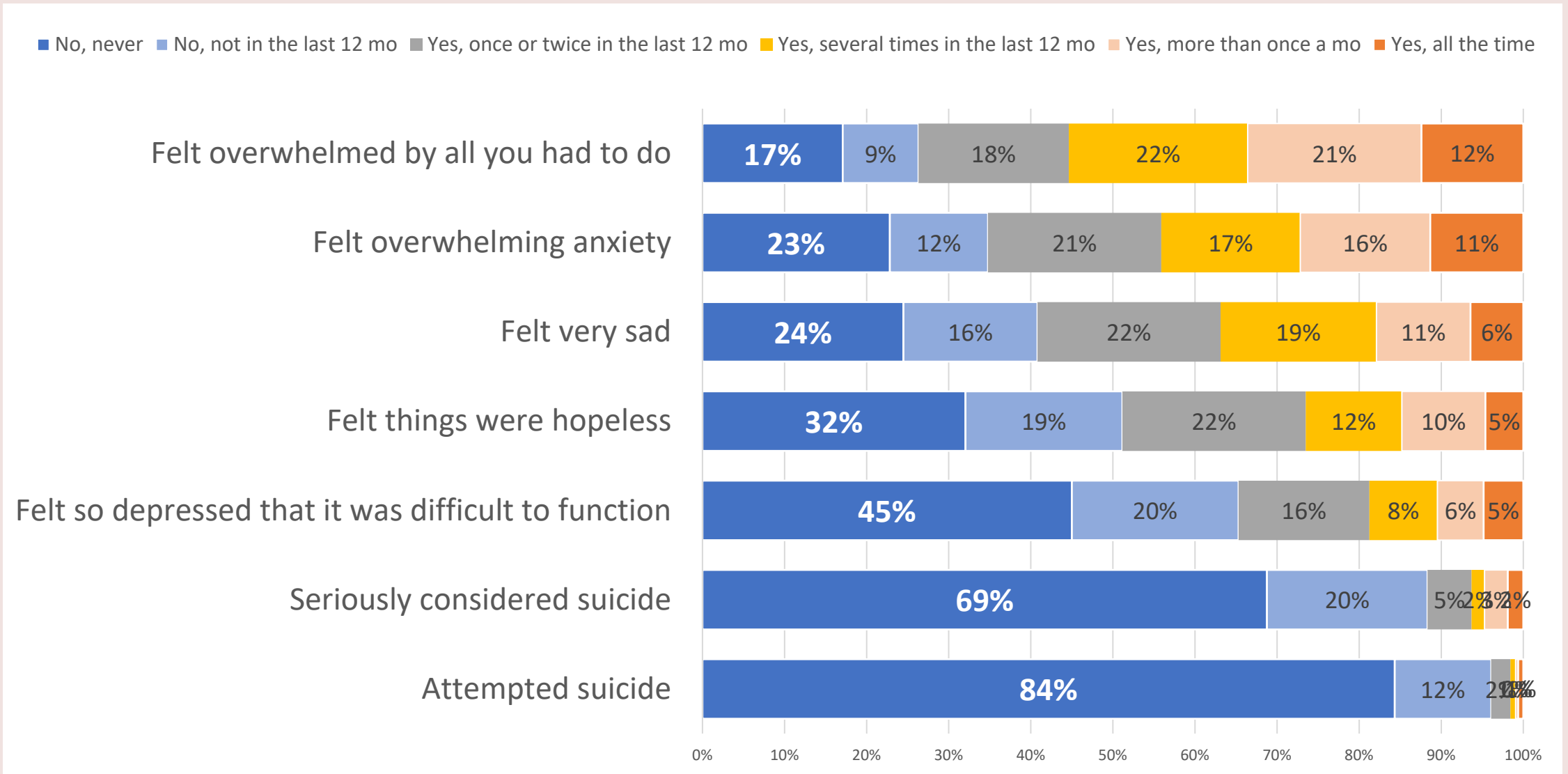
QUESTION: At Las Positas College, there is a general respect for differences in:



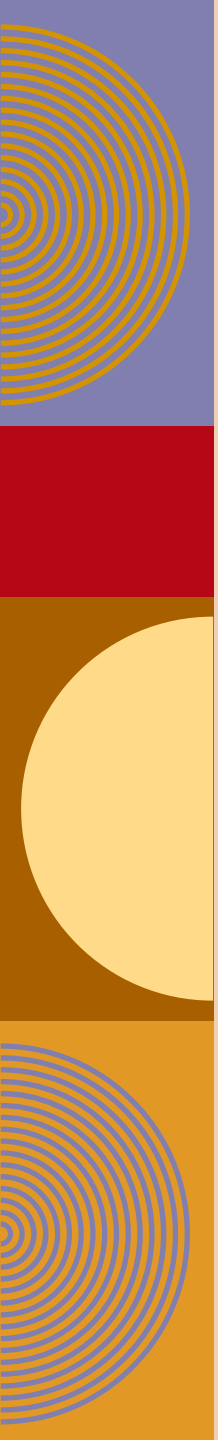
HIGHLIGHTS: HEALTH & WELLNESS

- In the last month, about 1 in 3 students felt
 - Overwhelmed by all they had to do
 - Overwhelming anxiety
- In the last month, 3-4 students in a class of 24
 - Felt hopeless
 - Felt very sad, or
 - Felt so depressed it was difficult to function
- In the last month, 5% of students have seriously considered suicide.
