Join us for a get-together of fun, friends, food, and fabric for a very deserving cause. It's a QOV quilt block party!



Frequently asked questions

Do I need to wear a Mask? Masks are not required at this time.

Do I need to bring a Quilt of Valor Project or will one be provided?

 We have several different block kits and an ample supply for everyone. It's a block party. Quilters make blocks, blocks make tops and tops makes quilts.

What supplies will I need to bring?

- You need to bring your sewing machine, extra needle, thread, bobbins, pins, and any other items you enjoy sewing with. You will need an extension cord/surge protector to connect to the power strip on the table.
- DO NOT bring a personal iron as we will overload the circuits and we will lose electrical. There will be ample pressing stations available for your use.

What will be served for lunch?

- We are serving various Costco ciabatta sandwiches, potato salad, Red Peppertomato soup & Caesar salad. Also, yummy snacks throughout the day.
- o If you have food sensitivities, please feel free to bring your own lunch, however, you will still need to pay the \$25.00 registration fee.
- We will also provide coffee, decaf coffee, tea, hot cocoa, bottled water, muffins, and cookies. Please feel free to bring your own drinks if needed.

Where do I park?

- There is ample parking on the streets around the Veteran's Memorial Hall. Save parking space and ride with a friend.
- There will be a sewing machine drop off zone indicated by orange cones at the Fifth Street side ramp entrance for your convenience.
